### FAI MEDICO-PHYSIOLOGICAL COMMISSION (CIMP)

### **Introduction:**

FAI CIMP has been existence for 100 years as the FAI "Aero-Medical and Physiological Commission". Its national delegates interact on various levels as recognized experts. They are in general experienced physicians, pilots and aero-medical specialists. They serve as advisors their respective National Aero-Clubs, governmental authorities and other aerospace related organizations. As FAI representatives they counsel the organization on air sport related medical and physiological questions. Heart of the CIMP mission is the "safe and healthy pilot performance".

### Tasks:

- 1. Support and Consulting EAS, WADA, NAC's and ASC's:
  - "Human Performance and its Limitations" in Aviation
  - Championships: First Aid, Real Life Support, CISM (Grand Prix 2014)
  - General advise to NACs, "Europe Air-Sports" (EAS) and EASA on Medical Licenses / Rulemaking
- **2. FAI-CIMP Delegates in the International "Aero-Medical Network":** Air-Sport related issues, Discussion Forums and Presentations:

#### 3. Support in FAI Anti-Doping:

- TUE Panel: Certification of international level FAI Athletes
- FAI Anti-Doping Advisory Group: follow up work of the FAI AD Plan

## 4. Plans for further CIMP projects and activities:

- High priority is given to scientific global aeromedical communication of related performance issues and flight safety aspects in air sport.
- Publish aeromedical Concerns in CIMP Minutes after CIMP workup. (i.e. "Approach" to ICAO, FAA, EASA for Better Accident Statistics)
- Publish aeromedical CIMP Info for distribution on CIMP Web-Site
- Development of modern Basic Human Factors briefings for ASCs

Commissions Presidents meetings take place as a rule in May and October. These are excellent opportunities to discuss aeromedical questions and its concerns with ASC's or other FAI members. This can help to identify and solve further upcoming problems in the FAI community.
