10. Access details:

By road, railway and by air:

The City of Banja Luka is up north in BiH, 330Km West of Belgrade, 200Km North of Sarajevo and about 200Km SE of Zagreb. The city is easily accessible from the main highway Belgrade – Zagreb – Okucani, Exit – Gradiska – Banja Luka 45Km as well as by railway. It is even possible to come to our DZ in your own plane, via custom registration and police check at the International Airport Banja Luka, which is only 5 Km away from our DZ. You will find more information about connections with the town of Banja Luka at www.banjaluka-airport.com. The event site Airfield Zalužani is next to the main road Gradiska – Banja Luka- Jajce – Sarajevo. More details at the web site of the Official Banja Luka Tourist Board: www.banjaluka-tourism.com. The organizer will arrange to meet teams and officials at the Train station, the International Airport Mahovljani in Banja Luka and take them direct to hotels. Therefore, Delegations and IPC Officials should announce their arrival with exact timings. There is a direct connection from Zurich to Banja Luka Airport. See more details at www.bhairlines.ba

12. Weather Conditions:

The climate in the BiH is moderate continental. During the month of August, the average

temperature in Banja Luka is 23°C and the average wind direction is NNE with an average speed of 1m/sec.

13. Insurance:

Each competitor must have valid medical insurance covering repatriation costs and the Third

Party Insurance for 30.000,00 € Event liability insurance covering officials, Judges, etc. shall be arranged by the Organizer. Immediate medical care (First Aid) is the responsibility of the Organizer during the official duration of the event, including the training days. There will be two ambulance vehicles with the reanimation equipment and personnel and also on duty medical personnel at the DZ (2 doctors).

14. Aircraft details:

The Organizer is providing Pilatus PC6 airplane for AE, (right door exit), with an exit speed of 140 Km/h (+ or -10 Km/h), and the reserve aircraft will be L410.

The Organizer will provide an L 410 – Turbolet / for FS, exit speed 180 km/h (+ or - 10 Km/h), left door exit with FS grip for exit.

16. Training prior to competition:

For training jumps we will use the same types of aircrafts as determined in Paragraph 16. Training jumps from L410 will start on August the 8th.

Training jumps from PC6 will start on August the 10^{th} .

The price of the jump for – 4-way open and 4-way female – will be 20 EUR per jump. The price of jump from – 8-way, VFS, AE – will be 22 EUR per jump.

Each AE participant will have 2 official training jumps, others will have one.

The Organizer can provide accommodation, food and transport upon request.

Organizer is suggesting to all interested parties to notify their possible arrival for Prior

competition training at least 60 days in advance, in order to provide effective arrangements.
