Recommendation to establish INTERNATIONAL WORLD PARACHUTING RANKING LISTS

*The IPC Bureau and the IPC Committees are directed to implement
a ranking list system for all parachuting disciplines.*

Principals for ranking on the lists

The IPC will rank NACs

Position in 1st Category Events will count towards ranking.Different 1st Category Events have different importance.

Events over the last 4 years count towards ranking.

Value of points earned degrades yearly.

Calculating the individual event

The best individual or team from a NAC count towards the ranking.

The points earned depend on:

- The result of the event (**R**)
- How important was the event (**I**)
- When the event took place (**A**)

These factors are brought together in the following formula to ascertain the total number of points (**P**).

$$P = R \times I \times A$$

The following criteria apply to the calculation of points:

R: Points for result

Individuals or teams earn 100 points for 1st place, 99 for 2nd place, 98 for 3rd place etc.
NB: Since 2013 points start at 250 for 1st place, 249 for 2nd, 248 for 3rd etc.

I: Importance of the event

World Parachuting Championship I = 3
Regional Championship or World Cup I = 2

A: When the event took place

Additional criteria

If two NACs share the same sum of points they will share position on the ranking list.

If a 1st Category Event includes both a Regional Championship and a World Cup the individual or team will only receive points towards the ranking of one of the two. Individuals or teams participating in both events will earn points based on the result of the Regional Championship. The remaining individuals or teams will earn points based on the result of the World Cup.

The ranking list will only be updated when a new event result enter the list.
