5. 2023 FAI General Conference and CASI Meetings Report by CIAM President, Antonis Papadopoulos.

The FAI General Secretary informed that the election was performed only for CASI. A lot of activity was performed by FAI office and the IT development training, about antidoping, for the sport commissions. Mr Delor is member of CASI. The next General Conference will be in Saudi Arabia in November 2024. For the finance, the expenditure will be different between membership and commercial income. The FAI staff was reduced, but good experience was lost.

The CIAM President informed that the there was a discussion about the General Section document to be revised in few items. For the appeals, the sanction fee was increased to 3000 CHF. Some experienced layers suggested to strictly follow the rule since last year two appeals have been requested. CASI organised on-line training for the Juries.

The medal legend award was well appreciated by the attendances. Other airsports will introduce a medal legend award. The amended Code of Ethics was appreciated and considered very important.

19. 2023 Drones World Championship in Korea

The CIAM President explained how the Championship was held with the aid of a video.

20. Upgrade of F9U class from provisional to Official with Championship Status

Mr Delor is proposing to upgrade the F9U class from provisional to Official class. He also proposed to host the championship in odd years.

21. Any other

It was pointed out to take care of the UAV rules section while preparing the Bulletins for FAI CAT1 events.

Issues

22. Judges' education and qualification - Possible use of a tool

Some tools can be used for evaluating the F2B, F3A, and F4 categories. It was mentioned that it is required that all the judges are aware of the general rules.

23. Entry Fees - Review of the concept

The CIAM President presented a table for defining the entry fee costs based on the cost of life index of the country where the championship may be held. It was discussed during the meeting and various comments were provided. The CIAM President will distribute the table waiting for comments and suggestions.

ACTION: CIAM President and CIAM Bureau members

24. Section 4 – Sporting Code renumbering and format

It was announced that in 2025 there will be the task to harmonise the sporting code volumes of the various CIAM disciplines.

25. Online participant's registration to CAT1 events

It was proposed to use the e-navigator application for the registration of the participants to the CIAM CAT 1 events. CIAM President will contact Noosphere and FAI IT Manager for the next steps.

26. Jury and Judges panel composition for CAT2 events

Various problems were identified using the required number of international judges at the CAT2 events: like for Australia and USA. Various proposals were discussed, like having only one international judge or making exceptions for some countries. SM S/C Chairman will prepare a list with the current status and then we will be able to decide.

27. Bulletin - 0 Template

The existing Bulletin 0 template, needs to be improved to introduce the new rules, and new information and to remove not applicable any longer provisions:

- Adding 10 CHF as an additional fee for each competitor and team manager
- COVID statement not required anymore.
- Introduce phases 1, 2, 3 for increasing participation.
- Introduce UAV rules requirements per country if required.
- Introduce classification for Juniors and Females with at least 6 for championship title.
- Introduce awarding with only diplomas for Juniors and Females when less than 6 participants.

28. Insurance provided by the organizer

Attention must be taken to the insurance statement that the CAT1 organisers use to include in the bulletins 0. This is to avoid that some responsibility could be considered for FAI.

29. CIAM forms update

Many CIAM forms are obsolete and need to be made up to date. This will be discussed in April

30. CIAM web pages update

The CIAM web pages need to be constantly up to date for all disciplines and categories using photos as well.

31. Future of the Trophies (cost of transportation, missing Trophies)

A discussion started for making easier and cheaper the management of the trophies for their transportation. Various solutions were discussed including defining standard dimensions, choosing a specific courier or locating the trophies at FAI.

For the FAI trophies in Russia and not returned to the championships, we have to decide if to create a replica or a copy of them.

Activities

32. Status of official classes with championships with no events

Some provisional classes haven't been yet offificial.

33. Education S/C - Rookie Project

The CIAM President pointed out the advantage of having this subcommitte and projects like this. Only CIAM has this strong education subcommittee. New ideas could be implemented for the Space category.

34. Meet with the Champions - On line presentations

We have to prepare a webinar. The CIAM President asked the Subcommittee Chairmen to suggest possible candidates.

35. IT Projects

For IT currently we have in place the AMS and the CIAM Judges and Technical Experts applications. The CIAM President presented the new application and the repository for the CIAM Events history. The history started back in 1951. The database needs to be filled with the data relevant to World and European Championships and World Cups. There will be about 1300 CIAM CAT1 events and about 15.000 CIAM CAT2 events.

Another survey will be developed for presenting the activity of the various NACs.

The CIAM President made some proposals for this tool. They were discussed but further discussions will be continue in the future.

36. CIAM Legends medal review

In 2024, two more medals should be awarded.

37. E-airsports

Mr Delor is confirming that this category attracts a lot of youngsters and the simulators are used for practising the competitors. Further discussions will be necessary. A detailed plan will be preared and the CIAM will take care to finance this activity.
