Raising the maximum age for participants of the JWGC 2022

The JWGC 2021 was delayed due to the COVID-19 situation in 2020. At that time team selection had started or was even finished in many countries already and the teams were already preparing for the upcoming JWGC 2021. In most countries this also includes pilots born in 1996 who, according to the current rules, would not be able to participate in a delayed JWGC 2022. Furthermore, these pilots would lose one opportunity to fly a JWGC, for some being the only JWGC they were able to qualify for. We therefore propose to raise the maximum age for participants of the JWGC 2022 by one year. Going back to the procedure described in Annex A 1.3.4 b. from 2024 on.
