**3. Amendments to Rules for 2021.**

The landing rules have been extracted from the rules of all three disciplines and written into a separate document. The meeting approved the removal of landings from our rules, and reference to the landing appendix, subject to the final submission of this appendix from the Precision Sub-committee.

**4. Approval of Local Rules for WRFC2021.**

The WRFC2021 committee has reviewed their budget and plans and submit and amended Local Rules for WRFC2021. (As attached).

The essential changes are, Dates adjusted by 1 year and while their cost have increased, the net results is a ~ 5% increase in Euro terms at current exchange rates.

The date for final payment C5.3 was changed to 15<sup>th</sup> July.

The effects of the current lockdowns due to COVID19 were discussed, and currently European nationals are not allowed to fly to South African, the Buro was tasked to monitor the developing situations and key decision dates are 14<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021 before the opening of the entries and 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021 for a final decision.

**5. WRFC 2023 – France**

Philippe Muller will be the competition director and he is considering either Vichy or Issoire as a possible venue.

We expect the final bid to be presented at the GAC meeting in Stellenbosch in November 2021.

**6. WRFC 2025 – Ravenna, Italy**

The Aero Club of Italy expressed interest in hosting the 24<sup>th</sup> World Rally Flying Championships in Ravenna, Italy.

**7. WRFC 2027 - Germany**

The German Aero Club have been requested to consider the 25<sup>th</sup> World Rally Flying Championships.

**8. Website for Rally Flying**
