15 MARCH 2019

YOUTH CAMP BUDGET

7 APRIL 2019

COUPE D'EUROPE SANCTION

To sanction Coupe d'Europe 2019 to be a CAT.2 FAI/CIA sporting event. Jury to be approved after EDS and Jury recommendation.

23 APRIL 2019

BUDGET APPROVAL

11 MAY 2019

12 MAY 2019

NATION RANKING DIPLOMA

The Bureau has chosen a format to create a nation ranking diploma and will work on this to be available for World and European championships.

8 JULY 2019

SAFETY OFFICER CHANGE AT CE CUP

The Bureau approves the appointment of Goran Grgič as Safety Officer during the 1st Women European Cup, CE Cup 2019, 3rd Central European Cup, 39th Hungarian National Championship and 4th Szeged Cup 2019. He replaces Rainer Hassold who had to cancel.

2 DECEMBER 2019

5TH JUNIOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2021

After approval from EDS the bid from Poland for 2021 Junior worlds was accepted by the bureau.

6 DECEMBER 2019

OPENING INTENTIONS TO BID FOR WWC2022 BEFORE PLENARY

The decision by plenary to have the Worlds organized in Turkey as part of the WAG becomes obsolete as the WAG got cancelled. The bureau decides that the Worlds in Turkey are consequently cancelled as well and to re-open the bidding process.

We give all countries the opportunity to bid for the world championships d.

1. A letter of intent must be submitted before the plenary starts on March 21, 2020.
2. The timing of awarding the event will be discussed in the plenary and we will either vote on the bids at the 2021 plenary or ask the Delegates to let the bureau decide after EDS has reviewed the bids.
