Motors for S2/P must be NAR safety certified and contain less than 30 gm of propellant.

If you need to send motors to the meet, please ship them to Matt Steele.

Only Adrel altimeters can be used for S2/P.

Adrel altimeters will be available for rental for a \$80 refundable deposit, or competitor can supply their own.

This meet will also be sanctioned to register flights for the USA Team Scoreboard, NRC scoreboard, and a NAR Record Trials. Come fly!
