THE HELLENIC OLYMPIC COMMITTEE IS PROUD TO NOMINATE MRS. KATERINA NAFPLIOTI - PANAGOPOULOS AS A CANDIDATE FOR THE 2011 IOC WOMEN & SPORT AWARDS.

MRS. KATERINA PANAGOPOULOS WAS APPOINTED BY THE GREEK MINISTRY OF CULTURE TO THE POSITION OF AMBASSADOR OF GREECE TO THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE FOR SPORT, TOLERANCE AND FAIR PLAY IN 1998 AND CARRIED OUT HER DUTIES EXCLUSIVELY ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.

THE INSTITUTION OF NATIONAL AMBASSADORS WAS CREATED BY THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE IN 1996. THE ROLE OF THE AMBASSADORS IS TO ENCOURAGE FAIR PLAY, TOLERANCE AND RESPECT FOR ONE ANOTHER, TO SET UP EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND TO PROMOTE ETHICAL VALUES AND GENDER EQUALITY IN AND THROUGH THE PRACTICE OF SPORT. THE FIGHT AGAINST RACISM, XENOPHOBIA AND ALL OTHER FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION IS AN EQUALLY IMPORTANT PART OF THEIR MISSION. MOREOVER, MRS. PANAGOPOULOS HAS FOCUSED ALL HER ACTIVITIES ON DEVELOPING WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION IN SPORTS AS ATHLETES AS WELL AS IN SPORTS ADMINISTRATION.

IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE HER GOALS, SHE REGULARLY PARTICIPATES IN A MULTITUDE OF INTERNATIONAL MEETINGS AND CONVENTIONS ORGANIZED BY WORLDWIDE GOVERNMENTAL AND NON GOVERNMENTAL INSTITUTIONS, SUCH AS THE INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC COMMITTEE, THE UNITED NATIONS, UNESCO, THE INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC ACADEMY, THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE, THE INTERNATIONAL MILITARY SPORTS COUNCIL (CISM), VARIOUS SPORT AND ATHLETIC CLUBS AND FEDERATIONS. SHE IS OFTEN INVITED TO ADDRESS SUCH AUDIENCES ON THE SUBJECT OF FAIR PLAY FOCUSING ON GENDER EQUALITY.

SINCE HER APPOINTMENT AS AN AMBASSADOR OF GREECE TO THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE FOR SPORT, TOLERANCE AND FAIR PLAY, SHE WAS IN CHARGE FOR THE IDEOLOGICAL PART OF THE OLYMPIC GAMES IN ATHENS 2004. THUS, SHE WAS RESPONSIBLE TO IMPLEMENT FAIR PLAY PROGRAMS, DESIGNED BY THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE FOCUSED ON THE PROMOTION OF THE SPIRIT OF FAIR PLAY TO ALL SPORT AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AND TO DISSEMINATE THE OLYMPIC IDEAL AND THE PROMOTION OF SPORT AMONG YOUTH. I STRONGLY BELIEVE THAT MRS. PANAGOPOULOS CONTRIBUTION TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FAIR PLAY MOVEMENT AS THE IDEOLOGICAL BASIS THAT UNDERLIES ALL THE OLYMPIC GAMES, BUT ESPECIALLY THOSE OF ATHENS 2004, WAS OF GREAT IMPORTANCE. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT ALL HER WORK IS ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.

IN ANTICIPATION AND IN PREPARATION OF THE ATHENS OLYMPIC GAMES 2004, MRS. PANAGOPOULOS ATTENDED AND ACTIVELY PARTICIPATED IN NUMEROUS CONVENTIONS, CONGRESSES, CONFERENCES, SEMINARS AND EVENTS.

- MR. EDDY O' HARA, M.P. CHAIRMAN OF THE BRITISH HELLENIC PARLIAMENTARY GROUP ORGANIZED AN EVENING DEDICATED TO THE OLYMPIC GAMES OF ATHENS ENTITLED "THE ETHICAL DIMENSION". MRS. PANAGOPOULOS WAS INVITED TO DELIVER A LECTURE IN THIS CONTEXT ENTITLED "FAIR PLAY AND ANCIENT CONCEPT A NEW APPROACH" (MARCH 2001). THE EVENT WAS ORGANIZED AT THE GRAND COMMITTEE ROOM OF THE HOUSE OF COMMONS IN WESTMINSTER LONDON. THE LECTURE WAS ATTENDED BY DELEGATES OF THE BRITISH SPORTS MINISTRY, THE FOREIGN OFFICE, THE BRITISH OLYMPIC COMMITTEE, MPs, AMBASSADORS AS WELL AS A LARGE AUDIENCE.
- THE GREEK EMBASSY IN LONDON AND THE HELLENIC CULTURAL CENTRE ORGANIZED A SIMILAR TO THE AFOREMENTIONED EVENT (MARCH 2001). MRS. PANAGOPOULOS DELIVERED A SPEECH ON THE DISSEMINATION OF THE ETHICAL VALUES OF FAIR PLAY.
- HER PERSONAL CONTACTS, EXTENSIVE DISCUSSIONS AND CONSTANT COMMUNICATIONS CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TO THE COORDINATION AND COOPERATION OF VERY IMPORTANT INSTITUTIONS FOR THE PROMOTION OF FAIR PLAY. THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION, SPORTS, HEALTH, PUBLIC ORDER, ENVIRONMENT AND THE GREEK ORTHODOX CHURCH. THROUGH THE SAME EFFORTS SHE MANAGED TO ATTRACT SUPPORTERS AND SPONSORS FOR THE FAIR PLAY.
- MRS. PANAGOPOULOS ORGANIZED AND FINANCIALLY SPONSORED, IN COOPERATION WITH THE
 MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND SPORTS, A MUSICAL CONCERT WITH THE FAMOUS MUSICIAN GORAN
 BREGOVIZ AND HIS ORCHESTRA AT THE STADIUM OF "PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP", IN ATHENS
 (FEBRUARY 2000). THE ONLY OBJECTIVE WAS TO PROMOTE THE FAIR PLAY VALUES. THE AUDIENCE
 OF THE EVENT CONSISTED OF APPROXIMATELY 10,000 STUDENTS AS WELL AS MANY DISTINGUISHED
 PERSONALITIES OF THE POLITICAL, SOCIAL AND SPORT LIFE IN GREECE.
- THE MINISTER OF SPORT AND PRESIDENT OF THE LASTING COMMITTEE OF EDUCATIONAL AFFAIRS OF THE HELLENIC PARLIAMENT INVITED MRS. PANAGOPOULOS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SESSION WITH SUBJECT "THE ROLE OF ANCIENT OLYMPIA AT THE OLYMPIC GAMES OF 2004" IN ORDER TO DELIVER A SPEECH REGARDING THE PROMOTION OF FAIR PLAY AND THE IMPORTANCE OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION IN THE UPCOMING OLYMPIC GAMES OF ATHENS 2004.
- MRS. PANAGOPOULOS ORGANIZED AND FINANCIALLY SPONSORED THE ANNUAL MEETING OF NATIONAL AMBASSADORS FOR SPORT, TOLERANCE AND FAIR PLAY IN ATHENS IN JUNE 2000. DURING THIS MEETING, MRS. PANAGOPOULOS PROPOSED THE MUSIC FROM THE OSCAR WINING MOVIE "THE CHARIOTS OF FIRE" TO BECOME THE FAIR PLAY ANTHEM.

EQUALLY IMPORTANT ARE HER ACTIVITIES IN GREECE AND HER PARTICIPATION IN DOMESTIC WORK AND IN NUMEROUS MEETINGS AND WORKSHOPS WITH CONTINUOUS VISITS AND SPEECHES TO SCHOOLS AND INSTITUTIONS ALL OVER GREECE TO RAISE AWARENESS OF THE AUDIENCES AND TO PROMOTE THE PRINCIPLES AND VALUES OF FAIR PLAY AND THE PROGRESS OF WOMEN IN THE FIELD OF SPORTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THEIR PLACE IN SOCIETY AT LARGE.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, IN COOPERATION WITH THE GREEK MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, ORGANIZED A NUMBER OF LECTURES AT THE MAIN CENTERS OF THE HELLENIC AMERICAN COMMUNITY ACROSS THE US, INCLUDING CALIFORNIA AND FLORIDA, SO AS TO ENCOURAGE GREEK AMERICANS, BOYS AND GIRLS, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ALL VOLUNTEER OLYMPIC WORK-FORCE OF THE FORTHCOMING OLYMPIC GAMES OF ATHENS 2004.

SHE FURTHER ATTENDED THE FIRST WORLD CONGRESS OF ATHLETIC SOCIOLOGY IN SEOUL, KOREA, WHERE SHE PRESENTED THE RESULTS OF THE SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH ON THE SOCIO-CULTURAL EFFECTS OF THE OLYMPIC YOUTH PROGRAM AT THE SYDNEY 2000 OLYMPIC GAMES.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS' WILLINGNESS TO REDUCE VIOLENCE IN SPORTS FIELDS INITIATED THE PROJECT "FAMILY SEATING" IN COOPERATION WITH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATIONS. ACCORDING TO THIS PROJECT, THERE ARE DESIGNATED GUARDED SEATS IN THE STADIUM, WHERE ONLY CHILDREN WITH THEIR PARENTS ARE ALLOWED TO SIT.

FROM 1997 TO 2000 MRS. PANAGOPOULOS WAS THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE PAN-HELLENIC WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION "KALLIPATEIRA", WHEREAS FROM 2005 UP TO NOW SHE IS THE ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION. "KALLIPATEIRA" WAS FOUNDED IN 1976 AND IT IS THE ONLY PURELY WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION IN GREECE WHICH HAS BEEN RECOGNIZED BY THE MINISTRY OF SPORT AND IT IS A MEMBER OF THE HELLENIC SPORTS CLUB ASSOCIATION (S.E.G.A.S.). "KALLIPATEIRA" HAS BEEN AWARDED DISTINCTIONS BY THE ACADEMY OF ATHENS, THE MUNICIPALITY OF ATHENS AND HAS RECEIVED THE GOLD MEDAL OF THE HELLENIC SPORTS CLUB ASSOCIATION (S.E.G.A.S.).

THE MAJOR OBJECTIVES OF "KALLIPATEIRA" ARE THE DISSEMINATION OF THE OLYMPIC IDEAL AND THE PROMOTION OF SPORT AMONG YOUTH AND ESPECIALLY GIRLS AND WOMEN. RIGHT AFTER HER ELECTION, BEARING IN MIND THE CRITICAL ROLE THAT THIS ASSOCIATION CAN PLAY IN PROMOTING FAIR PLAY IDEALS, HER FIRST AND FOREMOST CONCERN WAS TO PLACE THE FAIR PLAY PRINCIPLES AND VALUES IN "KALLIPATEIRA'S" OBJECTIVES. THUS, SHE TOOK THE INITIATIVE TO INCLUDE IN THE STATUTE OF "KALLIPATEIRA" THE PROMOTION OF THE VALUES AND PRINCIPLES OF FAIR PLAY, FOCUSING ON GENDER EQUALITY AND PROMOTION OF FEMALE SPORTS AND THE AWARENESS OF THE PARALYMPICS MOVEMENT.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS AS PRESIDENT OF THE PAN-HELLENIC WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION "KALLIPATEIRA"

- SUPPORTS EVERY EFFORT RELATED TO SPORTS, CHAMPIONSHIPS, VOLUNTEERISM AND CULTURE,
- ADVANCES WOMEN AND FEMALE SPORTS,
- PROMOTES THE ATHLETIC IDEAL, THE OLYMPIC SPIRIT, THE PRINCIPLES AND VALUES OF FAIR PLAY, THE OLYMPIC TRUCE AND THE PARALYMPIC MOVEMENT,
- CONTRIBUTES TO MODERN SPORTS INFRASTRUCTURE, MAINLY IN THE PERIPHERY OF THE COUNTRY,
- ORGANIZES NUMEROUS SPORTS, CULTURAL EVENTS, SEMINARS AND CONFERENCES AND PARTICIPATE IN SIMILAR MEETINGS AS WELL, SO AS TO BRING WOMEN INTO CLOSE CONTACT WITH CULTURE AND SPORTS,
- GRANTS YOUNG AND PROMISING FEMALE ATHLETES,
- ENDORSES PROVISIONS AND PROVIDENCE MEASURES HELPING RESTITUTION OF FEMALE ATHLETES DEBILITATED BY SPORTS ACCIDENTS,
- PROVIDES FEMALE ATHLETE PROFESSIONAL INTEGRATION FOLLOWING RETIREMENT FROM ACTIVE DUTY.
- ENCOURAGES EQUALITY BETWEEN SEXES AND PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN AND GIRLS IN SPORTS,
- ESTABLISHED THE "KALLIPATEIRA FAIR PLAY" AWARD FOR WOMEN ATHLETES AND THE MOTHERS OF THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC WINNERS.
- FIGHTS SPORTS VIOLENCE, DOPING AND RACISM AND
- PUBLISHES PRINTED MATERIAL AIMED AT PROMOTING WOMEN'S SPORT AND SURVEYS ON ISSUES OF INTEREST TO TODAY'S WOMEN IN THEIR CAPACITY AS MOTHERS, EMPLOYEES AND ATHLETES.

AS PRESIDENT OF THE PAN-HELLENIC WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION "KALLIPATEIRA", MRS. PANAGOPOULOS INITIATED A MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION WITH THE PRESIDENT OF THE HELLENIC MIGRATION POLICY INSTITUTE (IMEPO). IMEPO IS A GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION SUPERVISED BY THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR, PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND DECENTRALIZATION. IMEPO'S MISSION IS TO RESEARCH AND UNDERSTAND THE PHENOMENON OF MIGRATION AND CONDUCT SERVICES WHICH CONTRIBUTE TO THE DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AVAILABLE AND REALISTIC IMMIGRATION POLICY WITHIN THE EUROPEAN UNION'S FRAMEWORK.

ACCORDING TO THE MEMORANDUM, "KALLIPATEIRA" AND IMEPO IN COOPERATION WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES PROCEED TO FINANCE AND CONSTRUCT STADIUMS AND 5X5 SOCCER FIELDS IN THE PERIPHERY OF GREECE WHERE SECOND AND THIRD GENERATIONS OF LEGAL IMMIGRANTS LIVE FOCUSING ON THEIR NECESSITY OF INTEGRATION IN THE SOCIETY.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS' INITIATIVE, AS PRESIDENT OF THE PAN-HELLENIC WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION "KALLIPATEIRA" TO FINANCE AND CONSTRUCT A NEW HOSPITAL IN ATHENS FOR DIAGNOSIS AND PREVENTION OF HEALTH OF NEW ATHLETES (8 -18 YEARS OF AGE) IS ALSO OF GREAT IMPORTANCE. THIS VISION WILL BE REALIZED IN COOPERATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF CULTURE, THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH, THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, LIFELONG LEARNING AND RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS AND THE PUBLIC HOSPITAL "SOTIRIA". "KALLIPATEIRA", THROUGH ITS 34 CONSECUTIVE YEARS OF CONTINUOUS OFFER TO THE SOCIETY, FOCUSES ON A GREAT PROBLEM THAT EXISTS IN GREECE: EVERY YEAR, 40 – 50 YOUNG PEOPLE (8 – 18 YEARS OF AGE) LOOSE THEIR LIFE IN THE SPORTS FIELDS DUE TO LACK OF HEALTH PROGNOSIS. THIS HOSPITAL, THE "CENTER OF DIAGNOSIS AND PROGNOSIS OF YOUNG ATHLETES HEALTH", WILL BE DELIVERED BY THE END OF 2011.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, IN ORDER TO ENCOURAGE THE DISSEMINATION OF THE PARALYMPIC MOVEMENT DECIDED, IN COOPERATION WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES TO FINANCIALLY SPONSOR THE EUROPEAN PARALYMPICS COMMITTEE (EPC) GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN THE TOWN OF HERAKLION AT THE ISLAND OF CRETE (SEPTEMBER 2007). AT THIS MEETING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEES OF THE PARALYMPICS GAMES OF BEIJING 2008, VANCOUVER 2010 AND LONDON 2012 MADE EXTENSIVE PRESENTATION OF THEIR STATE OF PREPARATION AND INFORMED THE COUNTRIES ABOUT THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE GAMES WHEREAS MRS. PANAGOPOULOS HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS THE CONFERENCE AND TO MAKE A DETAILED PRESENTATION OF HER ACTIONS AND GOALS REGARDING THE ACTIVE ROLE OF WOMEN IN SPORT ACTIVITIES AND THEIR PARTICIPATION IN DECISION MAKING STRUCTURES.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION HER OBJECTIVES TO PROMOTE SPORTS AS THE HEALTHIEST WAY OF LIFE AND TO COMBAT DRUG ABUSE, TOOK THE INITIATIVE, IN COOPERATION WITH THE SOCIETY OF VOLUNTEERS AGAINST CANCER, WHICH IS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT NON-PROFIT ASSOCIATIONS ACTIVE IN THE BATTLE AGAINST CANCER IN THE SECTORS OF PREVENTION, EARLY DIAGNOSIS AND PSYCHOSOCIAL REHABILITATION, ACCORDING TO THE INTERNATIONAL PRINCIPLES OF VOLUNTEERISM, ORGANIZED AN ONE-DAY SEMINAR. THE SUBJECTS OF THE SEMINAR WERE THE PREVENTION OF CANCER, THE IMPORTANCE OF PROMPT DIAGNOSIS OF CANCER, THE CONFRONTATION, THE PHYSIOLOGICAL SUPPORT OF PATIENTS, THE SIGNIFICANCE OF SPORT IN GOOD HEALTH AND THE DOPING PROBLEM WHICH IS CONSIDERED ONE OF THE LARGEST ISSUES IN SPORT. THE SEMINAR WAS ORGANIZED ON MARCH IN ORDER TO CELEBRATE THE INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY (MARCH 2006). THE SEMINAR WAS OF GREAT IMPORTANCE SINCE NOTHING SIMILAR HAD EVER BEEN ORGANIZED IN GREECE BEFORE. THE SPEAKERS WERE DISTINGUISHED DOCTORS, PSYCHOLOGISTS AND SOCIAL WORKERS SPECIALIZED ON THE SPECIFIC SUBJECT. FEMALE ATHLETES FROM EACH SPORT FEDERATION WERE INVITED AND ATTENDED THE SEMINAR.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, AS AN AMBASSADOR OF SPORTS, TOLERANCE AND FAIR PLAY AND PRESIDENT OF THE PAN-HELLENIC WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION "KALLIPATEIRA" ESTABLISHED THE "KALLIPATEIRA – FAIR PLAY" AWARD FOR WOMEN ATHLETES AND THE MOTHERS OF THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC WINNERS. IN MAY 2005 SHE ORGANIZED AN AWARD GIVING CEREMONY FOR THE MOTHERS OF THE GOLD, SILVER AND BRONZE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC WINNERS OF THE ATHENS 2004 OLYMPIC GAMES. THE EVENT TOOK PLACE ON MAY 10TH 2005, ASSOCIATED WITH MOTHERS DAY. THE WHOLE CEREMONY WAS ESPECIALLY TOUCHING AND THE AMPHITHEATRE OF THE WAR MUSEUM, WHERE IT TOOK PLACE, WAS LITERALLY PACKED.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, SINCE 2005, IS MEMBER OF THE ADMINISTRATION COUNCIL OF THE INTERNATIONAL FAIR PLAY COMMITTEE. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, THAT SHE IS THE ONLY GREEK CITIZEN THAT HAS EVER BEEN SELECTED TO BE A MEMBER OF THIS COUNCIL AND SHE WAS UNANIMOUSLY SELECTED BY ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD. IT IS GREAT HONOR FOR HER TO BE A MEMBER OF SUCH A PRESTIGIOUS COMMITTEE HAVING AS HONORARY PRESIDENTS, MR. JUAN ANTONIO SAMARANCH, FORMER PRESIDENT OF IOC, COMTE JACQUES ROGGE, PRESIDENT OF IOC AND MR. KICHIRO MATSURA, GENERAL DIRECTOR OF UNESCO.

- THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR FAIR PLAY EACH YEAR AWARDS DISTINCTIONS FOR OUTSTANDING EXAMPLES OF FAIR PLAY ATTITUDES AND GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IN SPORT SINCE 1963. THE COMMITTEE PRESENTS THESE AWARDS ANNUALLY. DURING 2003 THE INTERNATIONAL FAIR PLAY COMMITTEE SELECTED MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, IN RECOGNITION OF HER CONTRIBUTION TO THE FAIR PLAY MOVEMENT, TO GIVE THE AWARD TO THE SELECTED ATHLETE WHO WAS HONORED WITH "THE ACT OF FAIR PLAY". - MRS. PANAGOPOULOS ORGANIZED THE ANNUAL FAIR PLAY AWARD CEREMONY OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR FAIR PLAY IN ATHENS IN DECEMBER 2004. THE CEREMONY WAS UNDER THE AUSPICES OF UNESCO AND MR. KOICHIRO MATSUURA, THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF UNESCO WHO ACCEPTED TO HAND OVER A FAIR PLAY TROPHY.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, SINCE 2000, IS A MEMBER OF THE INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL OF SPORT SCIENCE AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION (ICSSPE). AS A RECOGNITION OF HER DEDICATION TO PROMOTING THE IDEALS OF SPORTS, UPON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SECTION FOR SPORT, CULTURE, ETHICS AND VALUES, HER ARTICLE ENTITLED "THE OLYMPIC GAMES: THE ETHICAL DIMENSION. FAIR PLAY: AN ANCIENT PRINCIPLE, A NEW APPROACH" WAS PUBLISHED.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS HAS SIGNIFICANTLY CONTRIBUTED TO THE PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN AND GIRLS IN PHYSICAL AND SPORTS ACTIVITIES THROUGH ACTIONS WHICH HAVE CHANGED THE OVERALL VIEW OF FEMALE IN SPORTS. AMONG OTHERS, SHE HAS CONTRIBUTED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- REGIONAL SPORT INFRASTRUCTURE SUBSIDIES WITHIN GREECE. IN COOPERATION WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES, WHICH PROVIDE THE NECESSARY LAND, "KALLIPATEIRA" SPONSORS THE CONSTRUCTION OF 5X5 SOCCER FIELDS AND ATHLETIC STADIUMS. THESE MINI SOCCER FIELDS AND THE ATHLETIC STADIUMS AIM TO FACILITATE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY AND TO PROMOTE YOUTH, BOYS AND GIRLS, FOOTBALL AND ATHLETIC SKILLS. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE SELECTED PLACES ARE USUALLY IN THE BORDER AREAS OF GREECE, WHICH ARE IN GREAT NEED OF SUPPORT AT A FINANCIAL, SPORTS AND CULTURAL LEVEL. THE OBJECTIVES ARE, THROUGH THESE SPORTS FIELDS, TO ENCOURAGE MOTHERS TO INTRODUCE THEIR CHILDREN TO SPORT, TO NURTURE A SPIRIT OF EQUALITY BETWEEN SEXES, IDENTIFY, ENCOURAGE AND PROMOTE TALENTED FEMALE ATHLETES, PROMOTE SPORTS AS THE HEALTHIEST WAY OF LIFE AND SUPPORT THE SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF IMMIGRANTS.
 SPECIFICALLY:
 - CONSTRUCTION OF A 5X5 SOCCER FIELD AT THE ISLAND OF LEROS.
 - CONSTRUCTION OF A 5X5 FIELD AT THE ISLAND OF KYTHIRA.
 - CONSTRUCTION OF A 5X5 FIELD AT THE VILLAGE OF MARATHOKAMPOS AT THE ISLAND OF SAMOS.
 - CONSTRUCTION OF A 5X5 FIELD AT THE VILLAGE OF CASTELLI, AT THE ISLAND OF CRETE.
 - CONSTRUCTION OF 5X5 FIELD AT THE VILLAGE OF TRIGONO, IN THE PREFECTURE OF EVROS.

 - DISTRIBUTION OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT TO THE ISLAND OF KALYMNOS.
 - DISTRIBUTION OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT TO THE ISLAND OF ASTYPALAIA.
 - DISTRIBUTION OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT TO THE VILLAGE OF VOLAKAS, IN THE PREFECTURE OF DRAMA.
 - DISTRIBUTION OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT TO THE TOWN OF KONITSA, IN THE PREFECTURE OF IOANNINA.
 - DISTRIBUTION OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT TO THE TOWN OF KRESTENA, IN THE PREFECTURE OF ILIA.

• CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAINING ROOM AND SUPPLY OF ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT AT THE CHATZIKYRIAKIO INSTITUTION OF CHILDCARE AND THE CREATION OF THE 'KALLIPATEIRA JUNIOR SPORT TEAM". THE CHATZIKYRIAKIO INSTITUTION OF CHILDCARE, FOUNDED IN 1889, IS ONE OF THE OLDEST IN GREECE AND IT COUNTS OVER A CENTURY OF CONSTANT AWARDS FOR ITS SOCIAL CONTRIBUTION. ITS MISSION IS TO TAKE CARE OF THE ORPHAN AND HOMELESS GIRLS IN GREECE. TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION THE IMPORTANCE OF SPORTS TO EACH CHILD, THE ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT OF A TRAINING ROOM WAS DONATED. THESE FACILITIES FOR GYMNASTICS AIM TO SUPPORT THE APTITUDE AND TALENT OF EACH CHILD.

WITHIN THAT FRAMEWORK, MRS PANAGOPOULOS PROPOSED THE CREATION OF THE 'KALLIPATEIRA JUNIOR SPORT TEAM". WHICH WAS ACTUALLY APPROVED, FOLLOWING EXTENSIVE AND CLOSE COOPERATION WITH THE PRESIDENT OF THE INSTITUTION. THESE TEAMS, BASKETBALL AND/OR VOLLEYBALL, WILL BE COMPRISED BY YOUNG GIRLS LIVING IN THE INSTITUTION AND WILL PARTICIPATE IN CHAMPIONSHIPS. SPORT EQUIPMENT AND SPORT FIELDS FOR PRACTICING WILL BE OFFERED TO THE ORPHANAGE. HER VISION IS TO CREATE A NETWORK OF SUCH SPORT CLUBS, IF POSSIBLE, IN EVERY CITY IN GREECE. EXTENSIVE RESEARCH ON SIMILAR INSTITUTIONS HAS BEEN MADE AND THE POSSIBILITY OF THIS NETWORK HAS BEEN DISCUSSED WITH THE RELATIVE PRESIDENTS.

 WOMEN'S EPEE WORLD CUP IS THE MOST SIGNIFICANT SPORT EVENT THAT THE FRONTIER CITY OF FLORINA IN GREECE HAS EVER HOSTED. IN 2007, FOR THE FIRST TIME, THE CITY OF FLORINA, HOSTED THE WORLD CUP "FLORINA 2007" IN WOMEN'S EPEE. SINCE THEN, EACH YEAR THE COMPETITION TAKES PLACE IN THE SAME CITY, AS A REAL RECOGNITION OF THIS SUCCESSFUL ORGANIZATIONAL EFFORT. THE CITY BECOMES THE CENTRE OF WORLD FENCING FOR 2 DAYS.

"KALLIPATEIRA", THE SPORTS ASSOCIATION WHICH MRS. PANAGOPOULOS PRESIDES, RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF THIS ORGANIZATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN AND GIRLS IN FENCING AND THAT EVERY SPORT IS A FACTOR THAT CONTRIBUTES TO GOOD HEALTH, EDUCATION AND CULTURE, DECIDED TO BECOME THE FINANCIAL SPONSOR OF THIS EVENT ON AN ANNUAL BASIS.

AS A RESULT, SINCE 2008 THE ORGANIZATION HAS BEEN RENAMED AS "WOMEN'S EPEE WORLD CUP KALLIPATEIRA". AN ADDITIONAL ELEMENT OF INTEREST OF THIS COMPETITION IS THAT THE 2008 ORGANIZATION WAS A CRITERION OF SUCCESS IN A PRELIMINARY TEST FOR THE OLYMPIC GAMES IN BEIJING. THIS FURTHER JUSTIFIES THE PARTICIPATION OF HIGH LEVEL INTERNATIONAL FENCERS.

Contribution to the coaching of women and girls in physical and sports activities.

MRS PANAGOPOULOS REGULARLY PARTICIPATES IN HOSTING NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL MEETINGS AND CONVENTIONS. THESE MEETINGS PROVIDE HER THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISSEMINATE HER BELIEFS OF THE PECULIARITIES AND THE IDIOSYNCRASY THAT COACHING OF WOMEN AND GIRLS CONTAIN.

AMONG OTHERS, HER LECTURE DURING THE "FOURTH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF MINISTERS AND SENIOR OFFICIALS RESPONSIBLE FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORT" MINEPS IV, ON THE THEME "SPORT AND WOMEN" WHICH WAS HELD IN ATHENS (6 – 8 DECEMBER 2004, IS ALSO NOTEWORTHY. SHE HAD THE CHANCE TO PROPOSE ACTIONS TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE SAFE COACHING OF WOMEN AND TO ENSURE EQUALITY BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN IN THIS FIELD.

EQUALLY IMPORTANT ARE HER LECTURES AND SPEECHES AND HER PARTICIPATION IN DOMESTIC WORK AND IN NUMEROUS MEETINGS, WORKSHOPS, SCHOOLS AND INSTITUTIONS TO BRIEF THE PUBLIC ON THE SAME SUBJECT.

MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, IN ORDER TO ACCOMPLISH A SAFE, BETTER AND EFFECTIVE COACHING ENVIRONMENT FOR WOMEN ATHLETES IS PROVIDING ALL NECESSARY MEANS FOR THEIR TRAINING. THUS, AS A PRESIDENT OF "KALLIPATEIRA" BUT ALSO AS AN INDIVIDUAL, SHE FINANCIALLY SPONSORS THE COACHING OF MANY WOMEN ATHLETES. SHE STRONGLY BELIEVES THAT KEEPING YOUNG ATHLETES SAFE TAKES MORE THAN SPORT KNOWLEDGE. IT REQUIRES A COMBINATION OF ABILITIES. FEMALE ATHLETES SHOULD TRAIN IN A DIFFERENT WAY FROM MEN, SINCE THEY NEED TO ALTER THEIR STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING PROGRAMS FOR SEVERAL REASONS, UNIQUE TO THEIR SEX. FEMALE ATHLETES SHOULD UNDERSTAND THESE CONDITIONS WHICH WOULD HAVE A GREAT IMPACT ON THEIR ATHLETIC PERFORMANCE OR CAREER.

SHE HAS SPONSORED A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF GREEK ATHLETES AND TRACK CHAMPIONS. AMONG OTHERS THE FOLLOWING:

- FEMALE ATHLETES OF THE HELLENIC SPORTS CLUB ASSOCIATION
- A NUMBER OF TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONS WHO WERE NAMED THE "DREAM TEAM" OF GREECE (SPONSORED BY THE FAMILY OWNED SUPERFAST FERRIES SHIPPING COMPANY)
- THE MUNICIPAL NAUTICAL SPORTS CENTRE IN SOUDA BAY, CRETE. 12 SAILING BOATS WERE DONATED. TO HONOR MRS. PANAGOPOULOS, THE LEADING BOAT OF THE FLEET WAS NAMED "KATERINA" AFTER HER FIRST NAME.

- THE FEMALE ATHLETE OF SHOOTING, AGI KASOUMI, WHO HAS PARTICIPATED IN 6 OLYMPIC GAMES (LOS ANGELES, SEOUL, BARCELONA, ATLANTA, SIDNEY, ATHENS) AND NOW IS PREPARING FOR THE UPCOMING OLYMPIC GAMES IN LONDON.
- THE FEMALE ATHLETES OF THE HELLENIC FEDERATION OF FENCING.
- THE HELLENIC FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S BASEBALL.
- THE HELLENIC FEDERATION OF SYNCHRONIZED SWIMMING WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE ATHENS 2004 OLYMPIC GAMES.

- THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTERNATIONAL "FAIR PLAY" AWARD TO BE GRANTED YEARLY IN ANCIENT OLYMPIA BY A COMMITTEE CONSISTING OF LIVING NOBEL AWARD WINNERS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF INTERNATIONAL HUMANITARIAN ORGANIZATIONS, TO BE CHAIRED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF GREECE.
- THE ORGANIZATION OF AN INTERNATIONAL "OLYMPIC RECONCILIATION SPORTS TOURNAMENT". PARTICIPATING TEAMS IN THIS UNIQUE TOURNAMENT WOULD CONSIST OF ATHLETES FROM TWO COUNTRIES THAT WERE OR ARE PRESENTLY IN CONFLICT AND WAR. THE ATHLETES OF THESE TWO COUNTRIES WILL PLAY TOGETHER ON THE SAME TEAM AND WILL JOINTLY COMPETE TO WIN.

SPORT IS A SOCIAL FORCE WHICH HAS A GREAT BEARING ON SOCIETY AND THE STATUS OF WOMEN. THE MESSAGE AND VALUES PROPAGATED THROUGH SPORT CAN REACH A MAJOR PART OF THE POPULATION REGARDLESS OF SOCIAL CLASS. MRS PANAGOPOULOS, TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION THE ABOVE, IS WILLING TO EXPAND THE PAN-HELLENIC WOMEN'S SPORT ASSOCIATION THROUGH BRANCHES, IF POSSIBLE, TO EVERY CITY IN GREECE AND WORLDWIDE.

"KALLIPATEIRA" IS HEADQUARTERED IN ATHENS AND FEW YEARS AGO THERE WAS ONLY ONE BRANCH IN THESSALONICA. DURING MRS. PANAGOPOULOS PRESIDENCY, THE ASSOCIATION HAS EXPANDED AND TWO MORE BRANCHES HAVE BEEN CREATED. MOREOVER, HER COOPERATION WITH THE ASSOCIATION OF THE GREEK OLYMPIC AWARD WINNERS HAS BEEN IMPECCABLE. THE GREEK OLYMPIC CHAMPIONS SUPPORT ALL HER EFFORTS AND ARE ALWAYS PRESENT IN THE EVENTS SHE PARTICIPATES IN OR ORGANIZES. THIS SUCCESSFUL COOPERATION HAS A GREAT CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROMOTION OF FEMALE ATHLETES IN THE MEDIA.
