#### **Contest Rules:**

The competition will be held according to the present FAI rules and will be open for individuals with a valid FAI sporting license. NAR members may participate in the competition but will not be able to qualify for official awards. All events must be flown only with motors safety certified by the NAR for use in the USA. All motors must contain less than 30gm of propellant. Only Adrel altimeters can be used for S2/P. Competitors can bring their own, can rent or purchase them at the event for \$75.

#### Awards:

There will be separate awards for Juniors and Seniors. The best three performances in each event and overall best performance in the competition will be awarded medals.

#### **Protests:**

Protests are possible in a one-hour period after each category in writing, along with a \$5 non-refundable protest fee.
