## Summary of Activity Since Last Plenary

*HG Sport Class, 2, 5 and Women Class 1 World Championships – Groveland, USA:* In agreement with the organizers, these events were postponed to 2021 then cancelled due to COVID concerns as well as issues with new organizers/staffing.

*Class 1 Pan-American Championship – Big Spring, USA*: This event was postponed to 2022 then cancelled due to COVID concerns as well as issues with new organizers/staffing.

*Class 1 European Championship*– Monte Cucco, Italy: This event was scheduled for 2020, **but postponed to 2022** due to COVID.

*HG Class 1 World Championships – Krushevo, North Macedonia:* This event was postponed from 2020 to 2021. Additionally, the organizers have opted to include Class 5 as well as Class 1. The maximum number of pilots allowed will be adjusted, with the Plenary approval, from 125 to 140.

## **Proposals to the Plenary**

*Swiss Proposal to create safety working group:* The Swiss have proposed the creation of a safety working group to study overcrowding at Category 1 events and possible methods to increase participant skill level by decreasing maximum participant numbers. So far, there has been little progress.

## **Upcoming Category 1 Competitions and Bids**

2023 HG World Championships – We have received a bid for the 2023 worlds to be held in Ager, Spain.
