



CIVL 2020 PLENARY – ANNEXE 20
COMPETITION COORDINATOR REPORT

January 15, 2020

The information in this report has been collected from the WPRS website, from the email exchange between CC and event organisers, from the FAI website and the previous CC Reports.

Sanctioned Events

During the year of 2019 CIVL has received 332 applications for 391 Category 2 events.

Sanctioning process

In summer of 2019 FAI CIVL Cat 2 Online Application Management System (AMS) was put into action.

It became impossible to submit any application after the deadline. The system just refuse to save it in case the application was done past deadline. At the same time it became easier to make payment and get invoice. the system produces automatic invoices, that can be paid by PayPal in side AMS and set event as paid automatically. In 2019 61 applications were made via AMS

Apart from those organizers who have not managed to submit applications in AMS (which number is unknown) there were 3 events that were rejected cat 2 sanctioning as they were submitted past deadline.

Before AMS was introduced there were the following statistics:

- 6 event organizers have sent the letters with applications exactly on the deadline day
- 8 events sent the applications 1 day before the deadline.

- 11 sent applications 2 days before the deadline.
- 9 sent 3-4 days in advance.

NAC users were connected to AMS one by one. And the process is still ongoing. Not all NAC have staff willing to monitor AMS, for this case it is still possible to upload an Application for signed by your NAC to your online application form to get the event sanctioned.

In general NAC users are quite active and willingly participate and work with organizers.

Almost all submitted applications were approved by NACs except 1 - it was rejected.

Ranking of the non-sanctioned events.

In 2019 2 events were ranked without being properly sanctioned, as an exception and upon CIVL Bureau approval. 1 was Monarca in Mexico due to payment delay of Mexican NAC. The other one was HG Open in New Zeland due to NAC technical error..

Processing results.

Of 332 applications received in 2019 by the time of the preparation of the current report only 281 applicants have sent the results for their events. 25 applications reported event cancelled and 2 did not have a single valid task. 1 event was de-sanctioned by the reason of violation of Section 7 C rules.

There are still 22 applications missing any results or cancellation information. The Competition Coordinator has sent out the reminder to all applicants whose results are missing.

Up to the date of the report we have 318 event results in WPRS.

Task Validity

Within 317 events in the ranking 6 HG and 13 PG Cross Country events having 1 task only. But the majority still kept to 2-4 tasks per event which in not a bad result. For accuracy the majority of had 5-6 or more than 8 rounds. In Aerobatics the standard was 4-5 rounds.

Incidents/Accidents

In 2019 the organisers of 258 events (HG classes combined) reported 105 incidents with 2 death casualties. 105 incidents though include those where nobody was injured at all but the equipment was damaged.

Participation

In 2019 the participants of 317 HG and PG events have made 13860 registrations to take part in them. That is almost 1000 registrations more than in 2018. Most numerous were PG XC competitions with average participation of 64 pilots per event, followed by 36 in PG Accuracy and 30 in HG Class 1, 12 in HG Class Sport, 9 in HG Class 5. PG Aerobatics being highly requiring elite sport on average had 8 participants same for Class 2 with their 3 pilots.
