## Bid to host the 24th FAI World Hang Gliding Class 1 Championship- "Àger 2023"

## 1. Organisers

## 2. Name of the Championship

24<sup>th</sup> FAI World Hang Gliding Championship - Class 1 "Àger 2023"

## 3. Proposed dates of Championship

Pre-World 2022 (practice event): July 16<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup> 2022

## World HG Championship – Class 1

Registration: July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Opening Ceremony: July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Practice day,team leader briefing and mandatory safety briefing: July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Competition flying days: July 18<sup>-</sup>28<sup>th</sup> Closing & Prize Giving Ceremony: July 29<sup>th</sup>

## 4. Location of Championship

Flying site: Àger– Catalunya – Spain (42°0'16"N 0°45'57"E)

## 5. Launch sites

Flying site: Coll d'Ares in Montsec d'Ares (42°02'46.3" N 0°44'44.1" E) Launch site take off direction South and South West. Nearest towns: Àger 17km 30 min, on an exceptionally good, paved road from Àger to launch. Also,Tremp 46 km, Balaguer 57 km, Nearest larger city: Lleida 73 km and Barcelona (nearest international airport) 180 Km on a good motorway.

In 1995 Àger held the World Championship and the European championship in 2010. Also, several National Championships have been held in Àger; the latest were in 2010, 2012, 2015, 2016 and 2020.

The competition team is highly experienced. Jose Manuel Sánchez García (Juaki) has organized another World Championship 2001 in Algodonales, and with Gabriel Navarrete González, Joel Mirón de Soto and Nuria Moreno Barranco have organized several national championships, European Championship in 2010 Àger, among many other competitions.

We will run a Category 2 test event – Pre-world championship in 17<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> July 2022.

#### 6. Launch sites details

There is one launch area (1586m asl) with three huge ramps all of them facing South. Taking several aspects into account, we would be using two or three ramps on each launch and, to make the whole process more efficient and organized, we would be using "ordered launch" system.

The launch has huge rigging area that allow 120+ gliders.

The car parking area is also huge for many cars and vans.

There are no main hazards. The launch is faced to all the valley with many landing fields and the official one in Agulló

Big area on the launch that allow helicopter landings if necessary.



## **Official Landing Zone**

The official landing (42°0'32.641" N 0°43'35.605" E) is property of the organizer (Club Zenith Vol Lliure) It is located at 625 m asl and allows to reach it in safety from the launch. This would also be the official goal in some tasks.

The valley has many other landing options fields.



#### 7. Distance/access to launch site

From Àger 17 km on an exceptionally good, paved road, accessible on any type of car, no need of 4-wheel drive vehicles.

#### 8. Task flying area

It is a mainly safe flying area all around, with huge landings on the North and South valley. All the directions and tasks have good landings and in every briefing task the director will give pilots different options. The flying area combines flatland flying with ridge soaring Easy retrievals with good roads in many directions.

#### 9. Airspace

No major restricted/prohibited flying areas, but we will run with the correspondent NOTAM for both competitions

## 10. Safety Issues

Smooth to strong thermals along the ridge. Only some summer thunderstorms in the Pyrenees. These issues will always be considered when task setting.

## 11. Maps of task area

## 12. Transport

We will not provide transport services to launch. Pilots must drive up to launch by their own means. But we will provide a driver list and vehicle arrangements for those who need so.

## 13. Rescue/Medical Services

We will have an experienced on-site paramedic & first aid arrangement, the medical first response in task area & helicopter response time will be around 10 min.

First-line hospitals in less than 40 kms from flying areaTremp, Lleida and Barcelona.

## 14. Liaison with police, military, public services

We will have good communications with all of them if necessary.

## 15. Insurance

All pilots must have an insurance that covers the minimum required for FAI competitions. The organization has its own insurance for this event that cover the organization but not the pilots.

## 16. Communications

i) Radios: Details including any restriction on frequencies or types of radio, particularly 2m, and any licence requirements. We will mention the range of 2m frequencies that will be allowed in during the competition.

ii) Live Trackers. We have live tracking for the competitioniii) Exceptionally good4G Mobile/Cell Phone Coverage in all the area.

## 17. Weather

High time range of thermal activity in the months of July and August from 13:00 to 19:30.

The recommended maximum wind speed: on launch and for task flying will be 40 km/h.

#### 18. Meteorology

Experienced forecaster in many previous competitions and HG pilot. We will be using xcskies and arlnoaa web sites together with local wind stations of the flying area

#### 19. Event Headquarters

We will use the camping office with huge rooms for safety pilot briefings, registration and for equipment checks. We will have office equipment, Wi-Fiand charge point areas.

We will have online registration facilities for both events. All the relevant documents will be pinned on the web, together with maps, turnpoints, lodging facilities.
