

Checklist for organisers - equipment needed for Paragliding Accuracy judging at CIVL category 2 competitions

	Equipment	Number	Purpose
1	Pointers	As many as judges (it is also useful to have a couple of extras if the mat used does not cover the whole target area and there are places off the mat where landings cannot be marked with chalk for later measuring)	For marking the pilot's first point of landing
2	Chalks (2-4 different colours)	A small pack	For marking if there is no time for measuring
3	The tape measure	1 (at least the same length as the target radius)	For measuring the result
4	Adhesive tape	3-4 rolls of good quality	For fixing the AMD etc.
5	Red flag	1	For closing the target
6	Fixing pegs for target (depends on target material)	Depends on target material, as many as needed	The target must be flat and the carpet may need to be fixed
7	Brush	2	For cleaning the target
8	Broom	2	For cleaning the target
9	Cloth for drying	4-6 (depends on size)	For drying the target if wet
10	Cover of waterproof material	1 (little bigger size than target size)	For covering the target in case of rain/snow
11	Automatic measuring device + display	2	
12	Cover for AMD display	1	For protecting from sun/rain/snow
13	Target mat	1	A mat under the AMD and to cover the measuring area or a certain radius of it
14	Wind speed-measuring device plus poles and fixing pegs	2	For a wind speed measuring
15	Bright restrictive tape	30-40 m	For marking the radius of target if target is smaller
16	Bright restrictive tape	100 m	For limitations on access to the target area if there are no gates/fences etc.
16.1	Bright color spray (in case the target is on grass/snow)	2-3 (for same as 14, 14.1.)	Also useful for marking outer concentric circle (5 or 10m) if target mat does not cover the whole area
16.2	Solid reference folder	2	For the score writer
17	Pens	From 3 to 5 ball point pens (in winter other option)	
18	List of pilots for each round	depends on rounds	For writing the score and pilot's signature
19	Ready to use blank-templates	5	For complaints and protests
20	Windssocks plus poles and fixing pegs	1 according to S7C and a reserve system	
21	Seats for rest	Minimum 4-6	For rest
22	Umbrellas or portable shelter	So many that they give shadow to all judges	For rest
23	Tables	2, 3	For work and rest
24	Streamers		To show light wind around the target
25	Computer, printing possibility		
26	Video camera and tripod	1 with good resolution	For checking result (first point of landing) if needed
27	Radio	1 with fully charged battery	For communication with meet director and launch marshall
28	Tabards/vests/ T-shirts of visible colour (with CIVL logo for cat 1 competition)	Enough for all judges	For visibility of judges
29	A mallet	1	For hammering in the pegs if ground is hard
	A whistle	1	For event judge for announcing a pilot's final

The reserve equipment

1	Electronic measuring device (= pad)	1 or 2	
2	A mechanical wind speed recording device	1	A backup device in case of failure of electronic wind speed measuring devices
