FAI CIEA Meeting, Lausanne 26-27 April, 2013

Japan Aeronautic Association's youth activities in 2012 are outlined below.

We organized several programs that aimed to make children understand well and be interested in the air sports.

1. FAI Young Artists Contest 2013

We received 225 artworks from all over Japan. We made 12,000 leaflets and distributed them to many schools, museums, airports, newspaper companies, and various air sports events etc. There are a lot of children who applied by getting our information from our website and we don't have enough budget. So we made the number of leaflets decrease. We reduced print costs and mail costs.

We think Young Artists Contest is a good program to encourage air sports to the young people, and we made an effort to increase the number of entry for 2013.

2. Sky Kids Programs

We organized two programs under the name of "Sky Kids Programs". These programs aim to make children understand well and be interested in the air sports.

Children experienced air sports, and learned "the History of Flying" and "Introduction of Air Sports" by DVD that was edited by Japan Aeronautic Association for this program.

《 Sky Sports Class 》

"Sky Sports Class" is the program for the children between 9 and 11 years old. Children enjoyed flights by captive hot air balloon and paragliding and aeromodelling.

In 2012, it was held one time and their parents. A total of 59 children, 26 teachers and parents and 22 instructors participated. Both children really enjoyed it.



《 Aeromodelling Class 》

"Aeromodelling Class" is the program for the elementary school children. We organized 20 classes at different locations in the whole country. A total of 800 children, 68 instructors participated. Children assembled model planes and enjoyed flying.
