General


In 2022, the first year with normal conditions after the corona pandemic, GAC performed 2 World Flying Championships. From financial side this is highly appreciated.

Review 2021


Because of Covid-19 restrictions, there was only an income of CHF 109,18 Sanction Fees and no expenditure in 2021.


Outlook 2023
