Mr. Ján Šabľa is since 1992 continuously competitor in all International World or Continental Precision or Rally Flying Championships, as well as Air navigation Race for Slovak National Flying Team. He was competing in World Air Games in Antalya and Cordoba.

Ján was Chief Judge, Contest Director as well as competitor during many Slovak General Aviation Events in all 3 categories Rally Flying, Precision Flying and Air Navigation Race, where he become multiple Slovak Champion.
