Drinking Water

The DZ drinking water is pure fresh rainwater. There is a tap direct from the rainwater and also there is a chilled drinking water bubbler at the emplaning area which also has a water filter inline. So you may choose from fresh rainwater or filtered rainwater. Drinking water taps will be clearly identifiable and signed.

**** Please do not use any other taps around the DZ for drinking as these are dam water**

APF Membership

APF membership will be provided to all competitors for the duration of the event which will provide public liability insurance (NOT personal insurance)

Competitors require a valid FAI Sporting License

Delegates should look into their own needs in regards to any personal or travel insurance.

Speed Event

Speed event will be a Left Hand Carve

National Anthems & Flags

Winning teams will be required to ensure they have available for the closing ceremonies

- National Flag (size: 100 cm x 150 cm)
- National anthem available on a CD or available as an MP3

Travel from International Airport by train to Campbelltown

Team arrival in Australia

As per Bulletin #1 the organiser can provide a shuttle to the DZ on your arrival. ** This is a limited service and only available by pre booking and pre paying and on a first come first served basis.

Pickups from the International Airport will take longer, be prone to delays and there is no parking out the front of arrivals etc so coordinating , meeting and picking up is a lot more difficult.

However, as Campbelltown Station is only a 14-16min drive from the DZ at Picton, it is a lot quicker to get to Campbelltown Station and then we can normally arrange a lift from there with greater frequency. Trains depart from the International and Domestic Airports every 30min or so direct to Campbelltown train station.






