

If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited list for a medical condition, then he/she must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Official languages are English and Swedish.

Frequencies

The following frequencies are allowed in Sweden:

26.825-27.195 MHz (9 channels, 87-98, 04-24)

30.270-30.350 MHz (9 channels, 27-35)

35.000-35.270 MHz (28 channels, 60-87)

40.665-40.745 MHz (9 channels, 50-56A)

2,4 GHz

Please note that, according to the rules, each competitor must be able to operate two different frequencies, at least 20 kHz apart.

Flight tasks

Tasks and number of rounds to be flown will be announced at the briefing and may be subject to change depending on weather conditions.

Lodging

At the Arboga airfield there are some cabins that could be used. Price is $10 \in$ per night and person.

Camping at the field 8 € per night, electricity excluded.

If you want electricity (not for heating) included for tent or caravan its 15 € per night. Toilets and showers are available at the field.

Within 15 km of the competition site there is a camping site with self household cottages (three bedrooms with two beds in each room, price $20 \notin$ /bed and night) and camping areas (price without electricity $22 \notin$, with electricity $26 \notin$ / night). At the camping site is a restaurant that serves breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Please note:

Reservations for lodging at the camping site and cabins on the airfield or camping must be made in the final entry form so that the facilities will be available.

Catering and Banquet

Breakfast (8 \in) and lunch (10 \in) will be served at the contest site.

Breakfast $(8 \in)$ and dinner $(13 \in)$ can also be had at the camping site.

Banquet will be organised at the camping site $(50 \, \text{€})$.

Reservations for food are made in the registration form.

Meals on competition site

On flying days there will also be possible to buy coffee, drinks, ice cream and also some small snacks at the contest field.

Protest

The protest fee is 35 €.

Final Entry and Payment information

Final entry and all fees must be paid before APRIL 30 2011. This also includes optional payment for lodging, camping, and banquet according to the Entry form.

Entry fees paid after the APRIL 30 2010 must pay an additional 10%

Entry fees paid at the contest site will be increased by 20% and must be paid in cash.

Green event

The Swedish Model Flying Federation follows the climate policies, established by the Swedish Sports Confederation, in order to minimise the environmental influence connected to the competition.
