1. Organization

5th FAI European Championship and 8th FAI World Cup in Para Ski 2010 organised by

2. Aims of the FCE

- World Cup winners and European Champions in ParaSki individual – male and female separately,
- World Cup winners and European Champions in Team ParaSki – male and mixed gender teams together and then separately – female teams and junior teams,
- World Cup winners and European Champions in ParaSki Junior (born on or after 01/01/1986 - age of 24) – male and female separately,
- World Cup winner and winner of the European Masters Class ParaSki (born on or before 31/12/1960 – age of 50) – male and female separately.

3. Date and place of the FCE

10 - 14 March 2010 in Predazzo/Bellamonte – Fiemme Valley – Trentino – Italy.

4. General Information

Participation:

European Championship:

A maximum of 4 teams for the European Championships.

Three teams may be all male, all female, or of mixed gender, but there may be no more than 8 males or 8 females, in these three teams.

The fourth team may be composed only of juniors, or for each junior included in the three teams mentioned above, the fourth team may include one competitor of the same gender, who is not a junior. For a team to be eligible for Junior Team ranking, it must be composed of 4 junior competitors

World Cup:

Unlimited number of teams (4 members) per nation. Teams of mixed gender are allowed.

Training jumps: Wednesday 10th March 2010 from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.
The training will take place only if a minimum of 10 loads is achieved, the jumps must be booked in advance and the fee is € 30,00 each.

Training slalom: No official slalom training is foreseen. Each team can organize a ski training by its-self with the technical support of the organizing local ski-club.

Aircraft: Ecureuil AS 350 B3 or similar helicopter (4 parachutists) with an exit speed of approx. 80 kts

Drop zone: The drop zone can be reached only by skies, transport by snowmobile only before 0900 a.m. and after 1600 p.m. on request.

Personal requirements: To take part in the event, a valid FAI Sport Licence 2010, is required. **For the slalom competition the rigid helmet is compulsory.** Each participating country should also bring a national flag (size: 100 cm x 150 cm) and a tape/CD with the national anthem for the ceremonies. The flags and CDs/tapes should be delivered at registration.

Insurance requirements: Each competitor should have accident insurance valid; the minimum amount of coverage required in Italy by law is € 1.500.000,00
To comply with IT law it will be possible to obtain a time limited coverage at a cost of approximately EUR 30 to be paid on site. Liability insurance, covering Officials, Judges, etc., will be arranged by the Organizer. The immediate medical First Aid to the participants is the responsibility of the Organizer during the official event, including training days.

6. Entry fees

- Late entries are accepted until Saturday 13th February 2010 at 12.00 p.m. with a penalty of € 50,00 per person.
- Late payments are accepted until Wednesday 10th March 2010 at 5.00 p.m. with a penalty of € 50,00 per person.

If the two described situations happen together, the organizing committee will apply max € 50,00 of penalty per person.

The delegations that did not pay the entry fees in time are not allowed to take part in the competition.
