LOCATION OF THE COMPETITION SITE

The public airfield of Saarlouis-DUEREN (ICAO-designator: EDRJ) is located 10 km west of the city of Saarlouis, which has approx. 50.000 citizens and is located at the western border of Germany (very close to France and Luxemburg).

The city is easily accessible via two highways ("Autobahn") A 8 and A 620 and by train as well.

The dropzone elevation is 1.120 ft (= 341 m) MSL. It has a concrete runway of 800 m and separate taxiways. The operating time is daily from 08:00 am to 09:00 pm. During the competition there will be no other traffic than the dropping aircraft and skydivers.

There are full time dropzone facilities available, including a full time rigging shop. The local club has hosted the German Nationals 2009 in all skydiving disciplines and has accomplished more than 11.000 jumps during the 2010 season.

Transport service will be provided for initial access from the following airports or train-stations to the dropzone or hotels. Please note and register for the transport-service in advance on the attachment to the official entry form!!

Costs will be 30,- € each per transport for small groups (one to three persons) and 25,- € each for larger groups (four to seven persons). Depending on arrival times it is possible, that several delegations will be grouped together; this may cause some waiting at the airport.

- **Ramstein** (US-Airbase) for members of armed forces!

Train stations:

- **Saarlouis** (10 km = 15 min from DZ and 3 hrs from Frankfurt Airport Station (€ 35 – 50 one way))
- **Saarbrücken** (30 km = 30 min) (ICE and TGV-Station: travel time from Frankfurt = 2 h; from Paris = 2 h!)

Type: **2 x Do 28:** for 4-way Open and Female

2 x CARAVAN C 208 (normal and Grand):
for 4-way VFS; 8-way and Artistic Events

Description: Do 28: two engines, 15 jumpers;

C 208: one engine, 15 -21 jumpers

All A/C with left (inflight) door, with very similar dimensions of doors:
(H) 124 cm x (W) 127 cm (50 inch x 51 inch); rear video step and handles
inside and outside (roof); Exit speed: all A/C 80 kts (+/- 5 kts)

Each aircraft: 3 – 4 loads per hour

PRE-EVENT TRAINING CAMPS

The dropzone in Saarlouis operates every weekend from April on and will be open every day during specified weeks in May, June and July. For arrangements of your pre-training planning please contact the organizer at least 30 days in advance. Accommodation in the competition hotel with special price conditions will be available, as well as budget places on club level. Pre-competition training is also possible from Wednesday, 27th of July til Monday 1st of August out of the competition aircrafts. Please let organization know your intentions at **preliminary entry form!**

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

The use of an AAD is highly recommended for jumping at dropzone Saarlouis.
Main parachute must be open by 700 m AGL (= 2.300 ft)
Use of head protection is mandatory.

INSURANCE

Liability insurance, covering Competitors, Officials, Judges etc. will be arranged by the Organizer.



It is strongly recommended to all competitors to have insurance to cover for medical expenses and repatriation in the case of injury and for third party liability with coverage for situations not covered by SC 5, 4.5.3 (2). If necessary, the Organizer can assist in this matter. In case of problems please contact the organizer.

The immediate medical First Aid to the participants is in the responsibility of the Organizer during the official event, including training days.

Important: Any damage to the hotels etc. is in the responsibility of the persons/delegations involved. Personal items and equipment are under participant's responsibility.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

The **Preliminary Entry Form** of the NAC must reach the Organizer at least 75 days prior to the start of the competition, i. e. by **May, 18th 2011**.



The **Official Entry Form** of the NAC together with the **entry-fee payments** must reach the Organizer at least 45 days prior to the start of the competition, i. e. by **June, 17th 2011**. Please mind the additional "Attachment Form" with organisational details to be completed for **EACH** attending person.

Both registration forms are attached as papers to this Bulletin and will be available in electronical form (in format EXCEL 2003) on the organizer's website (www.epcwc2011.com). The registration by internet is the preferred method.

Payment must be made in EURO (EUR) by bank transfer. Bank charges to be paid by the sender. All forms with detailed payment instructions will be published with Bulletin No. 2 and on website www.epcwc2011.com not later than 1st of May 2011.

ENTRY FEES (incl. 90,- € FAI sanction fee, re. SC5, 4.1.3 and Official Entry Form)

Delegation members not or only alternating in parachuting activities: **550,- €**

Non-sanction fee paying (accompanying) persons at the event: **450,- €**

All amounts in EUR per person! **There is NO late entry fee!!**

ENTRY FEES COVER

- * for all competitors: competition jumps including one official training jump, re-jumps and tie break jumps
- * six times lunch (starting on 1st Aug. 2011) at competition side, six times dinner (starting on 1st Aug.2011), closing banquet
- * six times accommodation (starting on Monday, 1st Aug.2011) in ***S Hotel **(rooms with double occupancy!)** incl. six times breakfast. Single bed rooms upon request and availability will cost an additional fee of € 20,- (per person and night!!)
- * transportation from hotel to competition site if needed

Option 2: If a team wishes to arrange accommodation and meals (except Lunch at competition side) by themselves, than 300,- EUR per participant is deducted from the "full board"-option.

ACCOMMODATION:

For all competitors, officials and accompanying persons two ***S-Hotels in close vicinity of competition site are arranged. (See photos on competition website!) Hotel reservations for these two official competition hotels (including extra-nights!) **must be made exclusively** through the competition organizing committee.

Note: Payment for additional nights before and after the official arrival and departure day must be made separately and directly to the hotel: 40,- € person/night (incl. breakfast) in double bedroom. A limited number of single bedrooms is available at 60,- € person/night (incl. breakfast).

JUDGES TRAINING COURSE

A judges training course will not be organized at this event.

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATIONS

Each NAC can nominate up to four (4) teams into each event of the WORLD CUPS.

For the European Championship one (1) of the teams registered for the specific FS-events and two (2) of the teams for the specific AE-events must be nominated as official National Team(s) of each European country for the EPC-2011-classification prior the start of the competition.

Other delegation members will be specified in the Bulletin No. 2.

VISA SUPPORT

Participants/delegation members needing VISA for entering the EU/Germany, upon request will receive VISA support by the Organizer (e. g. letter of invitation. In this case, please send a list of all persons involved to the Organizer at hb@dfv.aero and attach a copy of their passports (page with photo and expiry dates as pdf or jpg-file).

PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM

A loudspeaker system will be used for announcements throughout the dropzone and a big screen will be provided to follow competition jumps and the rankings by competitors and general audience.
