IPC Branding / IPC name

- Proposal: **International Skydiving Commission (ISC)**
 - *Reasons: simplicity in branding: One name only. Skydiving includes skydiving (freefall), parachute jumping and Indoor Skydiving.*
- Parachute Jump: A parachute jump is a skydive **jump** by a person from an aircraft, an aeroplane or a spacecraft with the intention of using a parachute for the whole or a part of the descent to the surface of the earth.
- Indoor Skydive: An indoor skydive is the activity of body flight **and ~~aerial manoeuvres~~** performed by a person in a wind tunnel.
- Skydiving: falling through the atmosphere without a deployed parachute.
- Title of SC5: Parachuting and **Indoor Skydiving**
- Amendment of GS classes (para 2.1, 2.2, 2.7 : “Parachutes **and Wind Tunnels**” This has to be proposed to CASI, item at CG2019



Changes / new items on the agenda items:

- SC5 overall
 - Indoor AE Competition Rules effective May 1st (change to para 1.1.1 (6))
 - Junior description, para 1.1.2(9). **Will remain unchanged.**
 - Junior age Indoor Solo Freestyle, as per CRs, not in SC5
 - Para 4.1.4 (4). No change, so proposal deleted. **New text regarding exception to be provided by Judges Committee.**
 - Para 4.4.5(3). “the refund.... must be done by the organiser **within 14 days after** the decision regarding taking place of the FCE...”
Updated after comments from the Open Meeting.
 - Para 5.2.5 calling the jumpers: 2 separate paragraphs will be made, one for jumpers, and one for indoor skydivers. **The venue and logistics are too different and has to be defined.**



Changes / new items on the agenda items:

- SC5 chapter 6 judges
 - 6.7.1(6). Copies of all summary score sheets will be submitted to the IPC Judges Committee. **Will remain unchanged**
 - 6.7.5 Second Category Event: SCE **To be specified in definitions.**
 - All accepted proposals by the Judges Committee (CP 7 versus 9 Judges)



Changes / new items on the agenda items:

- **SC5 chapter 3 records**
 - Wingsuit committee proposal: include record acro longest sequence.
 - Para 3.3.3 FS and VFS total break large formation records, 2 separate paragraphs.
 - CF large formation sequential, separate paragraph
 - Para 3.1.2 (5), 2nd bullet. Sending claim to NAC by FAI. **Under discussion with FAI.**
 - Para 3.2.1.2 Tie-breakers, wording will include “performances”. **Request from indoor committee.**
 - Para 3.2.5.2, highest average. No change for open: 10 rounds. Added will be 8 rounds for juniors. **Current text all scheduled rounds is not correct.**
- **Internal Regulations**
 - Deletion of **IPC Records Officer** (para 5.9) **No specific person is deemed needed anymore.**

Changes / new items on the agenda items:

- **SC5 Annex 22.1.1 Austrian proposal**
 - FJ and FAI control cost to IPC: This proposal has financial implications. **R&R understands that Austria will withdraw this.**
- **SC5 Annex 22.1.4 Swedish proposal**
 - FAI controller act as Jury President: Committee would like to defer this matter and do research on the actual work and tasks by means of a elaborate questionnaire to the 2018 FCE Jury members.
- **FAI controller handbook**
 - Annex 4: Proposal by Finance Working Group. **This is accepted and will be incorporated.**
