

02.24 On-site communications

Personal radios provided for communication between Officials, Manifest and Support Staff.

Available wi-fi and phone lines on dropzone.

02.25 Local Safety Rules applicable to the event

Hard helmets mandatory for ALL jumpers.

AADs not mandatory for dedicated Canopy Piloting jumps.

Parachutes must be open by 800 m (2.625 ft).

All Safety Regulations in the official IPC canopy Piloting Rules will be followed.

A Ram Air main canopy and Ram Air reserve canopy are mandatory.

The reserve must have been repacked in accordance with the participants NAC regulations.

All participants must have a valid 2018 FAI Sporting Licence, issued by their NAC.

02.26 Visa requirements

Visas for EU/EEA citizens:

Citizens from EU or EEA countries do not require a visa to enter Poland. These include:

Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

Visas for non EU/EEA citizens:

Citizens from the following countries do not need a visa to enter when staying in Poland for less than 90 days: Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Bolivia, Brazil, Brunei, Canada, Costa Rica, Chile, Croatia, Guatemala, Honduras, Hong Kong, Israel, Japan, South Korea, Macau, Malaysia, Mexico, Monaco, Nicaragua, New Zealand, Panama, Paraguay, Salvador, San Marino, Singapore, Switzerland, United States of America, Uruguay, Vatican and Venezuela.

Rescue Helicopters are based in Regional Medical Center, 4 min flight from DZ, ~15min driving from DZ
