### **Selection process for 2015 competitions**

Supported judges by Organizers and CIVA:

EAAC: 7 judges

WAC: 8 judges

WGAC/WAGAC: 7 judges

The selection process was the same as in the past few years:

1. Judges with an RI of 5 or less, according to the data received from John Gaillard, were invited to make themselves available for the 2015 competitions. WAG in Dubai was excluded in this process.
2. The result of step 1 was published on-line at <http://civa-news.com/news/judge-selections-2015-championships>.
3. Delegates were invited to fill the remaining available slots with proposals. This step was open for everybody, including newcomers.
4. The JSC has voted on the applications and the final proposal for the lines, after being approved by the bureau, was published again online. Not all applications were taken into account.

### **Lines for 2015**

The tables shown below reflect the final compositions and not the result of the JSC voting due to last minute changes, even on site. These changes were either approved by the JSC or the International Jury of the competition concerned. Such changes are marked with an asterisk \*.

The changes in detail:

EAAC: The assistant of Jürgen Leukefeld couldn't make it to Deva due to personal obligations. She was replaced by Olga Romashova. Olga already worked on several judge lines as a scribe. She was found to be qualified by the international jury, the chief judge and the concerned judge.

WAC: In the days before the competition, Bill Denton originally selected as a judge had to cancel his participation due to health issues. The solution supplied by the US was to use Bill's assistant Marty Fluornoy as the judge and use Peggy Riedinger as his assistant. Both are well experienced and nationally and even internationally and have worked together many times. The change was

approved by the JSC and the international jury.

WGAC/WAGAC: Alain Dugas, who was originally selected as a judge had an accident during a display flight in France a few days before the competition. The good thing is that he is well again at this point in time. But he had to cancel his participation for WGAC/WAGAC by then. France proposed to use Remy Louvel as the judge and Christiane Persieux as his assistant. This change was approved by the international jury.

In addition every judge team has a scribe or better: Tablet Operator for the online scoring system. This scribe is selected by the judge himself.

Judge teams might switch for Power and Glider between judge and assistant.

The selection is based on the requirement to have judges who have judged Power and Glider during the past years on Worlds or Europeans. This requirement was set by the JSC as a precondition to the selection process.

The selection is confirmed by the bureau.
