Details of the Judges Work: <i>(including judging statistics)</i>	The work of the judges was satisfactory overall given the number of teams, I had decided to work only with two panels Rina's panel was in accordance with my expectations (cohesion rapidity judgment) ,she did a fantastic job. For Jim , it was more difficult, I thought he would be stronger and could take his role of event judge more firmly. It is regrettable that some judges try to impose their opinion, on the pretext of their seniority. It would appear that the competitors were satisfied with the judgment. Good experience for me as a chief judge.
Recommendations for Organisers:	Good organization; It would have been desirable to have a rest room for judges. Instead, this piece served for the jury . All my requests were processed quickly. Excellent work of Yasser, especially on the transportation of judges
Rule Changes Proposals:	The rule (5.3.1) for absolute need to be change like this: panel of 5 (4 to 1) and panel of 3 (unanimous)
Personal remarks:	Much criticism about my choice of judges, by 2 members of the IPC bureau . I had planned to withdraw from my position for this competition. In view of the work of the two colleagues, I am convinced that my choice was the good one. It is not easy to be at this place for the first time, and even less when one has undergone all these criticisms before the competition. I also note that the Jury, after consultation of IPC bureau, granted my request
