


3.2 Equipment specification

3.2.1 Competition skittle

3.2.1.1 Photographic or schematic representation of the item



3.2.1.2 Components required and method

Components required	Method
1 x grip (measurement, size, weight and type of handle to be specified)	1. Take the rope and attach the grip to one end and the skittle to the other as denoted in the graphic (method of attachment to be specified).
1 x red triangular flag (size and fabric type to be specified)	2. The bottom of the red flag is to be placed 20cms from the base of the grip. The flag is to be attached to the rope (method of attachment to be specified).
1 x rope measuring 7 metres in length to achieve the overall length of 6.82metres when constructed (rope gauge, material and colour to be specified)	3. The skittle will be attached to the rope (method of attachment to be specified) to give an overall length of 7 metres from the bottom of the position denoted by the red flag.
1 x red and white skittle 38cm in height, 1.6kgs in weight (skittle material, dimensions and type to be specified)	4. The skittle will weigh 1.6kgs (+/- 5% meaning the lightest acceptable weight is 1.52kgs and 1.68kgs the heaviest acceptable weight).
	5. The overall length from the bottom of the grip to include the skittle is 7 metres 20cms.
