Details of the Judges Work: (including judging statistics)	All judges were present in time and despite time difference ready to work. OmniSkore-scoring system: The good thing was that Ted Wagner was available on side and we where able to working on fixing upcoming problems where quickly. Problems like uploading the Videos correctly, showing not the right scores on the scoresheets – even when the calculation was right. I will send an e-mail to Ted with wishes for the future. The system, collecting videos of each team to determine the difficulty factor 48hours before the start of the competition has again proved itself well. This also speeded up the judging procedure. Participating Teams: Freestyle: 9; Freefly: 6 Both events were completed with 7 rounds. There were no Rejump and complaints. 1 protest which was given by the Jury to the Russian Freestyleteam and 1 safety violation to a GBR Team. Inclusive training jumps were scored 158 videos, The competition was because of the good weather situation completed in 2 days. The 7 judges (including 2 EJs) where organized a routating panel for FR Free- and Compulsory rounds also for FF Free- and also Compulsoryrounds. The panel worked efficiently and and brought the results out very quickly.
