

	<p>Style: 250 Training jumps (for all Judges)</p> <p>120 Competition jumps The Style judging was controlled by EJ, very well. All judges inkl. 2 new judges where very good. Only two round because we had problems with fire around airport. Work with camera by Drago Buncic was perfect</p> <p>Protest: Protest by head of Russian Delegation claimed that the Accuracy jumper , Andrey Finagenov's first strike was on the centre pad was with his left leg. The recorded score was 17 cm, indicating a point of first contact off the centre pad. The Protest claimed that the AMO had malfunctioned for that particular jump, citing previous malfunctions and rejudges having been awarded. The Jury having considered the evidence available, rejected the protest, on the basis that there was no evidence to show that the AMO had malfunctioned for that particular jump.</p>

Recommendations for Organisers:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The first contact with the organizers I had 3-4 weeks before the competition - too late - Everything was not prepared for the beginning of the competition - The Organisation was very small. (2-3 persons for all work) - Bad communication between the manifest and the organization - No official information about weather, daily schedule etc. - Bad distribution of water and bad Internet access for competitors. - Accommodation and food was very good.
Rule Changes Proposals:	-Max three years approved time for equipment. After that new reevaluation before new approve for another max. 3 years
Personal remarks:	<p>Insufficient number of judges from Europe. Several judges who send nomination for the competition were not on the list????</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Judges arrived 4 days before competition, not necessary. Two days is enough. - A lot of improvisation, because many things have not been prepared before. - Equipment for AL have failed. No signal, no results, no printer with so many problems it is very difficult to be credible and work a judge. Equipment for Style is old and limited.
