## **CANOPY PILOTING COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2019**

At the time of preparing this report, the 10<sup>th</sup> FAI CP World Cup 2019 and the 1<sup>st</sup> FAI CP Freestyle World Cup 2019 in Pretoria South Africa has not yet taken place. It is scheduled to take place from November the 19<sup>th</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup>. A more thorough report on the event will be given at the plenary but at this point in time we can only say that all the reports on the preparation have been satisfactory and that 101 competitors from 24 countries have registered. This represents a much better attendance than last year's World Championship.

The 8<sup>th</sup> FAI World Championship of Canopy Piloting 2020 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> FAI World Championship of Canopy Piloting 2020 was approved last year during the plenary and will take place with the Mondial in Tanay, Russia. We may expect an update from the organizer.

At this time there is no Bid in place for the 11<sup>th</sup> FAI CP World Cup 2021 and 2<sup>nd</sup> FAI CP Freestyle World Cup 2021. We encourage prospective bidders to contact the CP Committee for any assistance and advice.

There were two CP Judges Courses, in April in RSA run by Marylou Maughlin and in August in Klartovy by Björn Korth, with 4 new Judges and two re-evaluated Judges.

I would like to thank the members of the Committee for their work and support throughout the year, Mike Teague, Deputy Chair (RSA), Björn Korth (GER), Jasper Williams (RSA), Ian Bobo (USA), Nina Engel (GER) Rainer "Exi" Hoenle (GER), Agnieszka Solomon, (POL), and advisors Marylou Laughlin (USA), Greg Windmiller (USA) and Silvia Wagner (AUT).

And I would like to make a special recognition to Philippe Schorno, who has stepped down from the Committee this year, he has been working for IPC and the CP committee for the past 6 years. His hard work and advice have always been much appreciated and valued. His knowledge and experience in all areas of our sport have been an important contribution to our discipline.
