



## CIVL 2017 PLENARY – ANNEX 17B – V2 IPPI CARD REPORT

### **Issuing the IPPI Card**

As per our regulation, if all NAC have the right to issue the IPPI Card, CIVL may choose other associations to issue it. There may be more than one association per country issuing the IPPI Card.

It has been the case in Italy in 2016, where both the Aero Club d'Italia and the FIVL Associazione Nazionale Italiana Volo Libero have been issuing the Card. It will be the same in 2017, even though AeCI has requested to be the sole distributor.

In Mexico, where the NAC has never been issuing the IPPI Card, we allowed the Association of Paragliding Pilots and Instructors (APPI) to issue it in this country for its citizen and residents.

In Bosnia and Herzegovina, the NAC authorized APPI to issue it in this country for its citizen and residents.

Issuing through FIVL and APPI is subject to Plenary approval.

#### **There are currently two ways to issue the Card:**

- Per level, with a physical Card sold to whoever wants it.
- Per year, with a virtual Card (a logo associated with your national licence or equivalent) sold or given systematically to all pilots.

Four countries have chosen the virtual Card in 2016:

France: 11,030 pilots concerned.

Italy (FIVL): 3,790 pilots concerned.

Serbia: 91 pilots concerned.

Hungary: no information yet.

#### **The expected price structure in 2017, subject to Plenary approval :**

Per IPPI level:

- 1 to 99 pieces: 3 euros per piece.
- 100 to 499 pieces: 2.75 euros per piece.
- 500 to 999 pieces: 2.50 euros per piece.
- 1000 to 4999 pieces: 2.25 euros per piece.
- 5000 and more pieces: 2 euros per piece.

Per year:

- 0.20 euro per pilot, with a minimum charge of 50 euros.
