3. **Para-Ski Competition Rules:**

As a result of the last World Meet and the fact, that the Ski-Factor has not be changed for more than 20 years and the results of the top athletes in accuracy landing came closer in this time, the Para-Ski C'ttee proposes in line what was discussed at/after the competitors meeting in VRCHLABI following changes to the rules:

 - Caused by weather conditions or technical reasons the qualification run can be cancelled by the MD and CJ in agreement with the FAI- Controller
 - Lower the "Ski-Factor" from 0.32 to 0.5 – which means from 3cm/sec to 2cm/sec
