Temporary Working Group for Disabled Parachuting was created in 2016, with the aim of achieving many objectives. During these years with the great enthusiasm and assistance from French Parachute Federation there were conducted 4 HandyFly Challenges in different countries. And working group really hopes that this motion will find further support and interest from more countries.

Competition rules, written by enthusiasts from FPP are improving from competition to competition.

As long as a Handy category implies a classification of pathologies that would allow us to determine which type of competition for which type of Handicap. This is a classification that can only be made by the medical and specialized community and not by the sporting community alone.

Unfortunately such classification is not set yet, and it would be desirable to define it on the basis of this classification of which type of competition that the IPC could propose. And obviously write the associated competition rules. We are not there yet, the European challenge is the starting point for what could become future competitions, if we are able to meet this demand.
