6.4.1. *The World/Continental Championships or World Cup is comprised of:*

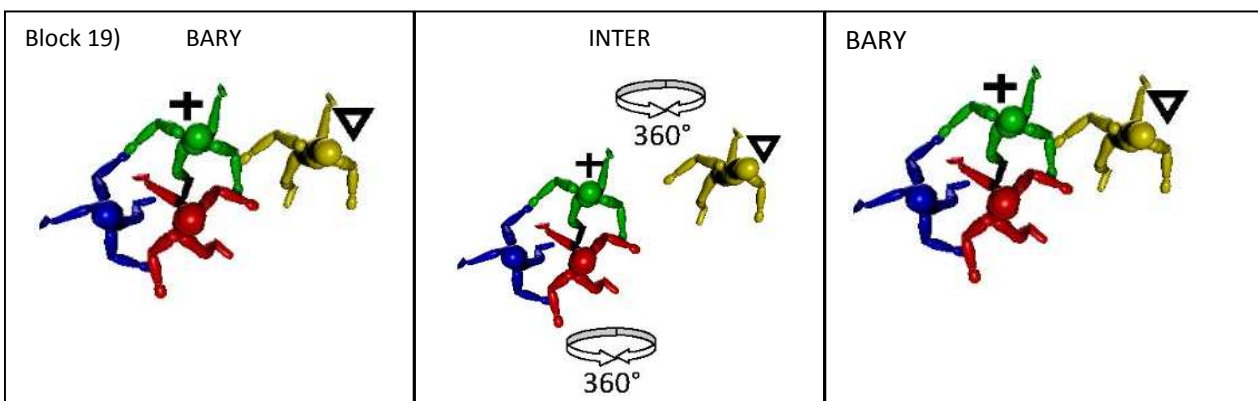
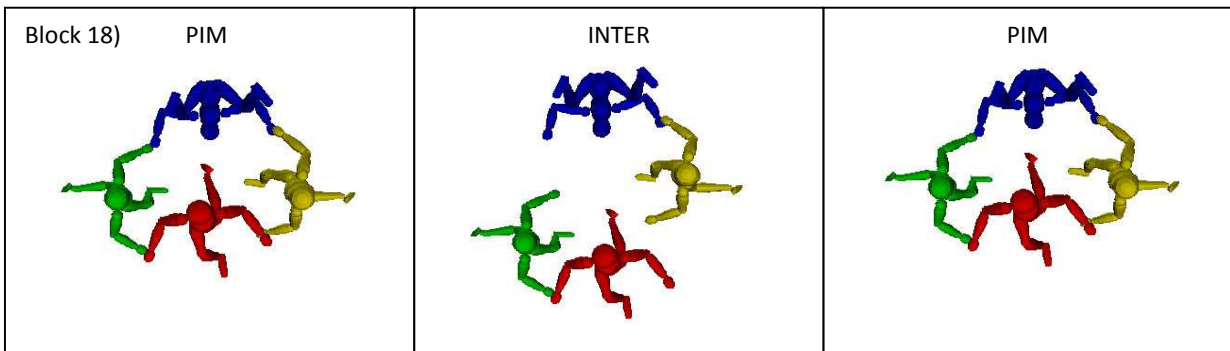
Formation Skydiving Events:

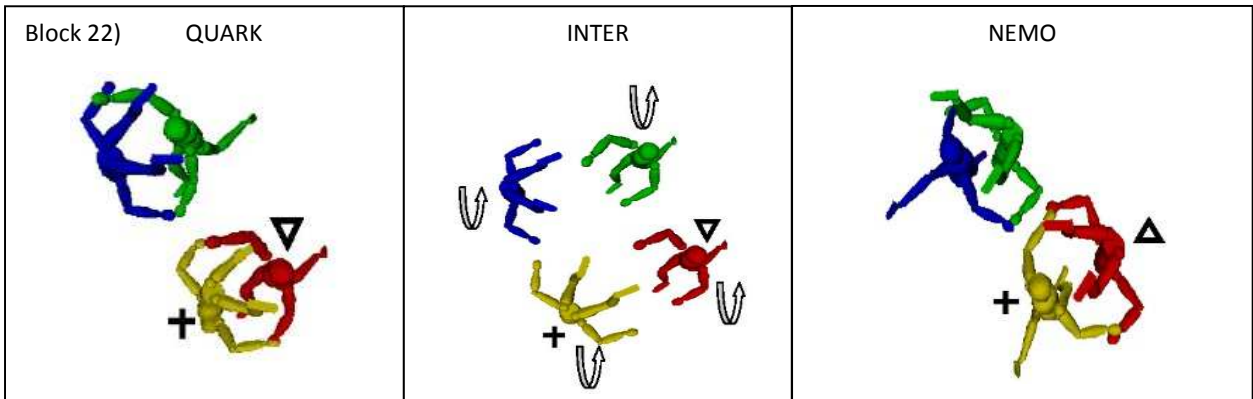
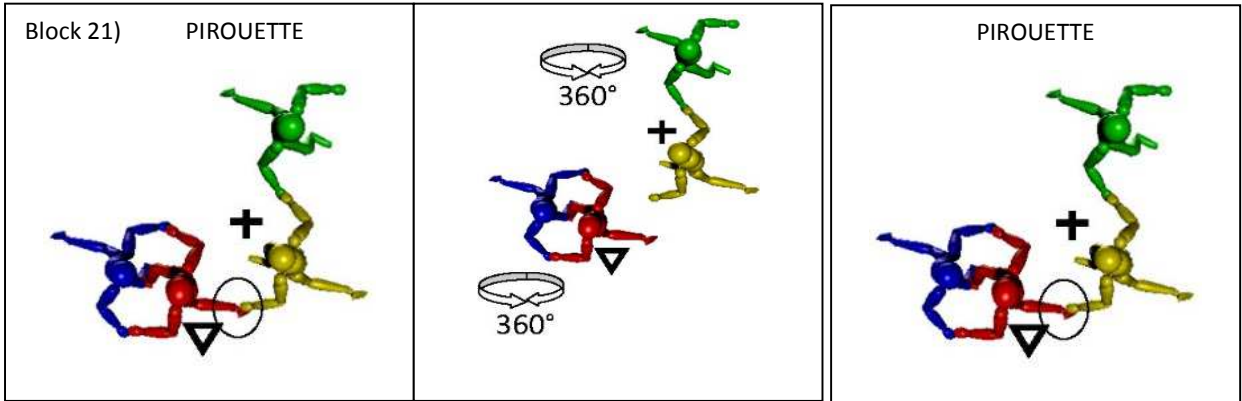
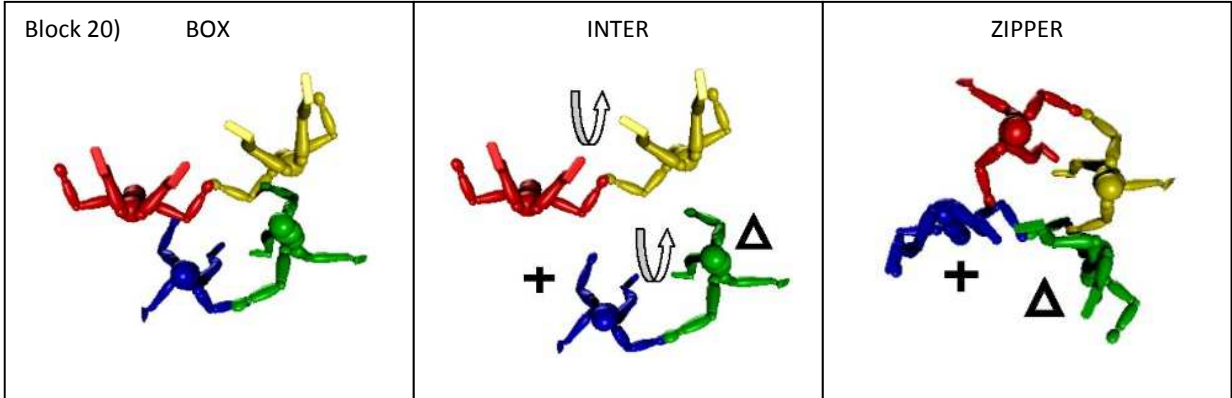
- Up to 8 rounds considered as selection rounds, and

Vertical Formation Skydiving:

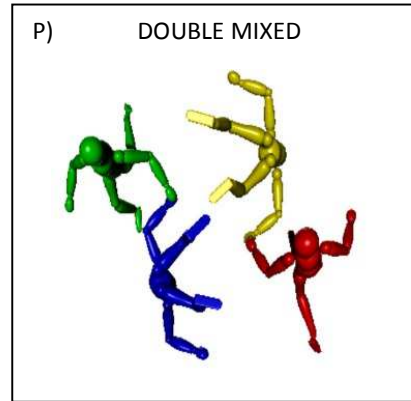
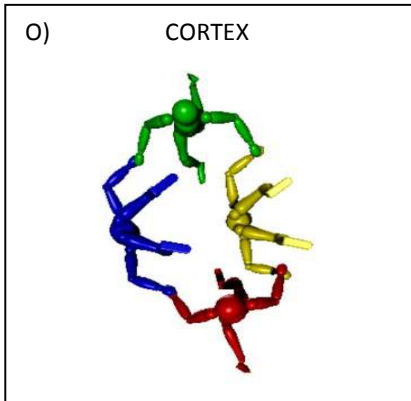
