Approved flight instruments

Following an issue that came up during a test event this year, the Bureau and several experts have examined certain instruments and determined that they may not meet the IGC requirements with respect to altitude measurements recorded in the IGC file.

It is necessary to review our requirements (conformity with IGC recording rules) and procedure to approve flight instruments.

The current list of approved flight instruments must be reassessed.

Instrument downloads

During the above test event, there was also an issue about direct download of the instrument at the organizer's request versus emailed tracklogs.

The Bureau request that the Plenary study the matter and comes up with a proposal that could be:

On organizers' request, tracklogs must be downloaded directly by the scorer. Tracklogs send by e-mail are then not acceptable.

All tracklogs must be kept on his instrument by the pilot until the results are official.
