Details of the Judges Work: <i>(including judging statistics)</i>	The Judges worked well as a team (with one exception – see below) and performed their work to the highest standard of diligence, efficiency and attention to detail. Acrobatic 49 jumps (no rejudges) Performance 345 jumps (including 3 rejudges)

Personal remarks: Vanandy but	I was very disappointed in Douglas Spotted Eagle, who proved himself to be arrogant and disruptive. He told the other panel members that they did not know what they were doing in Acrobatic judging and that 2 of the Performance penalties had been assessed against the wrong competitor. This was arrant nonsense and was totally false. I also believe (although I have no direct proof) that he passed information to US competitors about events in the judging room. He clearly regarded himself as superior to me and the others, was not part of the team, did not socialise with the rest of us and on the one occasion that we were all together for an evening meal, as my guests, he abused my hospitality by bringing along his wife and landing me with the bill, without one word to see if it was OK.
