

Proposal General Conference every two years

Proposal from Svenska Flygsportförbundet, the Swedish NAC, to investigate a change of the General Conference from an annual meeting to a meeting every two years

The FAI General Conference (GC) is an annual meeting according to 3.2.1.1 in the statutes. GC is a costly meeting for all parties; the organising NAC, the participating members and FAI. The chaotic organisation of this year's GC is a clear evidence of this.

The Swedish NAC prefers to finance air sport activities, not administration, and suggests that the GC is changed from an annual meeting to a meeting held every two years. There is a trend that more an more organisations change to less frequent meetings.

The Executive Board is elected on a two year basis already (the president is elected every fourth year), so the election of the board will not be affected by this change.

The main reason for the change is to save money and time for all parties. The meeting "Active President's meeting" could replace GC every other year when GC is not organised.

The Swedish NAC suggests that the Executive Board gets the task to investigate what the consequenses would be to change to a GC organised every two years, and, if feasible, suggest changes to the statutes to reflect such change at GC 2020.
