In accordance that the 3rd FAI World Indoor Skydiving Championship is almost two years ahead, we are flexible to include more disciplines in this event (i.e. 4way VFS female).

We think we have to be open minded because Indoor Skydiving Championships are pretty new and it can happen a lot in a short period of time.

## 2.4 Event Dates

Jochen Schweizer Arena proposes that the 3<sup>rd</sup> FAI World Indoor Skydiving Championship will be held from October 23-27, 2019.

The reason for this date is connected with the end of the trade fares season and consequently accommodations before. Also because of time interval between the 2<sup>nd</sup> World Championships 2017 in Montreal and the IS-World Cup 2018 in Bahrain.

- October 23, 2019: Arrival of Judges and Delegations, registration and open training period.
- October 24, 2019: Judges' conference, arrival of Delegations, registration, official training period, opening ceremony, competitors' and team leaders' meetings, Draws
- October 25, 2019: Competition
- October 26, 2019: Competition and closing ceremony
- October 27, 2019: Departure of Delegations

If there are a lot of Teams on the list we can easily start the competition on October 24, 2019 after the meetings and 2 hours after the Draw.

## 2.10 Details of Comprehensive Insurance

Erlebnisswelt München Betriebsgesellschaft mbH has comprehensive liability insurance. If Erlebnisswelt München Betriebsgesellschaft mbH will host the 3<sup>rd</sup> FAI World Indoor Skydiving Championship it will be easy to have more insurance if necessary. For our event center which is included in the Jochen Schweizer Arena we do have sufficient insurance for events anyway.

## 2.11 Details of Insurance Required by Participants

Erlebnisswelt München Betriebsgesellschaft mbH does not require tunnel flyers to carry third party liability insurance. Each participant will have to sign a Participant Undertaking and Risk Acceptance Statement. Competitors will however be responsible to get their own travel medical insurance. Competitors under the age of 18 will need a permission of their legal guardian.

## 2.12 Proposed Budget, Sources of Income and Entry Fees

All pricing for the event has been made in regards of the current IPC rules. Upcoming support from sponsors or other financial assistance will be used to reduce the entry fees, after deduction of additional costs (i.e. energy).

\* If a competitor is registered for more than 1 event, the additional event fee will apply to each additional event instead of the full entry fee. Each entry fee paying competitor, as well as a registered HoD, team manager or team coach in the delegation pays the IPC\_Sanction once per person, regardless of the number of events.

### **Non-Competitor entry fees:**

Entry fees for Heads of Delegation, Team managers, team coaches pay 500€ + Sanctions fee. Other Delegation Members or any other accompanying persons who are not part of an official delegation do not require a sanction fee and will pay 500€

### **2.13 Facilities**

On the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2017 the Jochen Schweizer Arena opened the doors to the public. So far we had over 20.000 people every month in our location. The Arena is located in the South-East of Munich and from above the whole arena looks like a rotor. Each blade is built to represent a different activity and have a space of 650qm. We can have 1200 people in the arena as a total.

The Surf Blade contains our indoor surfing wave, which can be mounted up to 1,40m. It's the first stationary indoor wave in Germany.

The Wind Blade includes our Indoor Bodyflying facility, it's the first in his art with an own Technology. The round glass is 5.90m high, the diameter is 14.5 feet and the tower containing the facility is 30m high. In this blade there are also 3 conference rooms (2x25qm,1x18qm) and a sanitary Facility which can be used by the Judges. The Wind Blade also has a second floor with about 75qm open space, from here there is a perfect view into the Tunnel. All preparation activities such as creeping can either be done in the Event Blade or the Wind Blade itself.

The third blade making the Arena exclusive is the 300qm Event Location, the flexibility of this space is demonstrated by the Multi-use during the whole Competition. The Opening and Closing Ceremony can be held in this Blade, providing all technological assets to make it memorable. Our Chef de cuisine and his Crew will provide a healthy Lunch and Dinner for all Athletes and Judges that will be served in the Event Blade. The second Floor of the Event Blade contains the Changing Rooms, Bathrooms and Showers. The Outdoor Facilities of the Arena allow Athletes, Visitors and the Judges to go for a walk and if the weather is good they can have some fun in our new Outdoor-climbing section, have a sit outside, even take a glimpse at the Alps.

In the middle of all the Blades we do have a restaurant with a capacity of 140seats. Therefore we can offer all competitors and accompanying persons food and beverages all day long.

#### **2.14 Windtunnel**

The Jochen Schweizer Arena Windtower is 30m high, including a 5.9m high Flight Chamber that has a diameter of 4.42m (round) with an innovated and specially created Technology. For the different Disciplines we can adjust the Airflow, by regulating our four Ventilators (each 330HP). Our Ventilators can reach a Wind Speed of maximum 300 km/h.

Even with over 200 competitors, the competition can easily be done within 2-days.

#### **2.15 Pre Event Training**

We offer Training Blocks for all Teams and Competitors of 1 Hour for 660€ including taxes, this can be split up into several periods. That means you can fly 1,2,10min-you do not have to buy 1hour!

Prices are subject to change according to the energy prices.

#### **2.18 Outline of Media Plan**

The Jochen Schweizer Arena is located close to Munich which has many local TV- and radio stations. Also Jochen Schweizer is a big name in Germany and even more in and around Munich.

So, as soon as we get the 3<sup>rd</sup> FAI World Indoor skydiving Championships we will start with promoting and Marketing to make sure to have as many as possible Media influence and finally a lot of time in TV and Radio. Jochen Schweizer does have intensive connections to the Media so this will be an easy part for us. Jochen Schweizer Arena has access to Sponsors, PR and social Media for the event and will assist fully as one company. Our Network has over 1 Million clients.

#### **2.20 Judging equipment**

Jochen Schweizer Arena will use the Intime scoring system owned by the DFV (German Skydiving Federation).

Our flight chamber is equipped with up to 4 cameras that cover the necessary angles for all disciplines and they can be hooked to the Intime system.

For Dynamic flying we will use the necessary lighting system in the pre events (3<sup>rd</sup> March 2018) and plan to do so at Nationals in March 2019) before the 3<sup>rd</sup> FAI World Indoor skydiving Championships and we guarantee that we will operate the latest and newest accepted version of software for the scoring system

### 2.21 Public Address System

A sound system is preinstalled and can be used to make announcements all over the Building. Our Arena has Monitors that are located in all Blades and they can be used for live judging/scoring.

### 2.22 Arrangements for Medical Care

Jochen Schweizer Arena provides a First Aid Care including a CPR responsible Person during the entire event. Ambulance services including fire fighter and the police will be available through 110 emergency calls. Klinikum Neuperlach is stationed 7,8km away from the Arena and therefore medical support can be granted in a short period of time.

### 2.23 Proposals for Event Officials

Travel costs, food and lodging for the FAI controller, the chief Judges and the assistant to the chief judge will be covered by the Jochen Schweizer Arena. All other judges will be provided with food and accommodation.

### 2.24 Details of On-Site Communications

Communication Outlets via phone and Internet are provided by the Jochen Schweizer Arena, internal and external communication is therefore secured.

### 2.25 Rules/Opening hours

The latest approved versions of Sporting Code Section 5 will be used. Also the newest version of Indoor Formation and Vertical Formation skydiving competition, Freestyle Competition rules and 2way and 4way Dynamic Competition rules.

It is required that all competitors wear a helmet during the competition. We do have opening hours 24/7

### 2.27 Medals

In case of a change in rules and regulations by the FAI and IPC, the Jochen Schweizer Arena would be able to fulfill the requirements of providing a drug test facilities on site prior and during the competition.
