Re: Operational Expenses in FCE, Jury adjustment proposal

Rationale:

The number of disciplines is increasing, in which the number of participants are not covering the cost of the mandatory competition officials despite having a sanction fee for each participant of € 90.00 before the competitor has even done one jump.

CASI this year initiated a Working Group comparing different approaches in all Airsports within FAI on how to reduce the expenses for Jury personal.

A review revealed, that some Airsport Committee only work with ONE Jury President sometimes together with a remote , others have one Jury President on site and remote Jurors electronically availability and some have one Jury President on site, who recruits 2 other qualified Jury members out of the persons present at the venue.

**The last version is applied in Paraski, where the FAI-Controller is the nominated Jury President in a personal united form and selects 2 more jurors on site. After this procedure was initiated Paraski is recording black numbers.**

A cross-section of costs for Officials, who are required for a FCE as mandatory personnel shows average costs of:

1 Juror at € 1500, 00 (including travel, accommodation, food, local transport)

1 judge at € 750,00 ( travel only, rest provided by organizer)

Except for Paraski each discipline has a cost for 3 Jurors of 4500 Euros.

Since every discipline is working with a different number of judges this will have an effect, which is shown below.

In red those disciplines where there is a loss every year, which cannot continue without trying to reduce the expenses.

In 2017 it is to expect that the disciplines losing on expenses claims will be CP and WS . The other weaker disciplines will be supported by being embedded in the World Cup events for FS.

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It must be our intention, to reduce the sanction fee over time and to avoid making losses with our attractive competitions.
