Proposal to specify Duties and powers in the Internal Regulations:

#### 4.3 DUTIES and POWERS

The Bureau shall act as a decision making body with the power to make decisions on matters which arise between Plenary meetings.

4.3.1 As stated in the FAI By-Laws 3.3.6 for decisions in FAI meetings, also decisions in the IPC Bureau and other IPC groups or Committees shall be made by simple majority with abstentions not counted.

4.3.2 As stated in FAI By-Laws 3.6.2 and IR 5.1.3.(5) the IPC President shall not take part in any vote, except for 4.3.3.

4.3.3 As stated in FAI By-Laws 3.3.7 if there is a tie in 2 successive votes of the same subject, the IPC President shall cast a decisive vote without appeal.

4.3.4 A decision brought forward by one of the IPC Committees needs Plenary approval  
The IPC Bureau does not have the power to decide against the documented statement of the Chair of the Committee if no Plenary approval is present.
