He was the first president of the FAP (Argentine Parachuting Federation) in 1962 and several subsequent periods.

He was also a delegate for Argentina and First President of the Latin American Confederation of PARACAIDISMO - March 1986, repeating his presidency in 2010 with the nascent Colpar XXI Century

Acting as Delegate for Argentina's NAC he assisted for various conferences and IPC/FAI and General FAI Conferences for 18 years plenary meetings.

He was TOP POP Argentina from 2012 to 2014

He is currently honorary president of the COLPAR (Latin American Parachuting Confederation), FAP (Argentine Parachuting Federation) and is the director of the Commission on Historical studies of FAP (Argentine Parachuting Federation)
