CIMA dates. Change from November to February.

Competition bids intended to give more time but has meant actually reversed.

Future Championships

WPC 2025 France.

Massive airfield site in East France, with long track record of hosting very large aviation events.

Needs a car to get there because nearest public transport links are a distance away.

Camping on site available. Wifi, kitchen facilities. Local hotels and private accommodation possibilities.

Gas station with Fuel.

Main concerns of organisers.

Safety

Environment- limited high speed tasks

ACOL Scoring system will be used

Prices €600 entry, €700 euro late registration

€150 for team leaders and assistants.

27 may - 1 June National Championships.

Questions:

Scoring is very different from S10. We ideally need to speak to the director in order to properly understand the scoring system.

Access to hangars? Yes

Flight limits on height?

AMOD for backup.

Very difficult to understand and approve scoring system.

Need list of explanation of formulae

We have only 3 months till cheap entry fee. Pilots need stability.

No explanation why changes have been made and philosophy of championship. Might be better than S10 but we need that explanation.

French pilots are used to this formula. Principles the same but precision of formulae can be very different tasks to strategise...

WPSC 2025 - Bornos

Team arrival 18 October.

19-25 October 2025

Accept that bid is late but decided to push ahead so the slalom pilots get a championship.

Bornos is well established as an excellent venue

Same setup as Qatar championship.

Model local regulations have been updated as proposals for this plenary.

Camping available nearby but not exactly on the same site. Equipment is better removed to campsite for evenings, not secure at the site.

490 Euro entry

Live streaming service with same TV crew that was used in Qatar – very experienced.

Lynx photo finish system used previously to be used again. Virtual gate, 0.001sec accuracy timing.

Live online scoring through dice.flights software.

Improved water rescue boat including new plate for backbone injuries. No divers but no need with pilot water rescue vests.

Voted to accept 16 in favour – 0 against – 0 abstention.

Monitor: No volunteers.

Jury: Rob Hughes, Hennie Brink, Wolfgang Lintl.

Steward:

Need an organiser agreement but this may have been sent already.

Final documents will be ready in 2 weeks.

Voted. 29 in favour of accepting the proposal!
