## **Proposal: Change the title and duties of the Record Liaison Officer**

Respectfully submitted by the Record Liaison Officer

**Motion:** to amend Internal Regulation 5.9 as follows:

5.9 RECORD ~~LIAISON~~ OFFICER

5.9.1 Appointment (**Unchanged**)

5.9.2 Duties (**Amended**)

**The Records ~~Liaison~~ Officer shall be the final ratification authority on all Class G International Records;** assist and advise FAI Members, Airport Organisations (ASOs), Meet Officials, and claimants in preparing the correct documentation needed to file International Records; advise and assist the Rules & Regulation Committee and the Plenary Meeting of desirable changes to the Sporting Code Section 5 with respect to International Records; be responsible for proper classification of Class G records; and be responsible for content management with respect to the IPC Records Search webpage. Certain procedures with respect to these duties are outlined in Sporting Code Section 5.

**Commentary:** The FAI Secretary-General has encouraged all Commissions to take a more active role in the ratification of their respective records. This change will allow IPC to take full “ownership” of our records process. The Ballooning Commission and the Aeromodelling Commission have done so some time ago.
