This year the CASI activities were not as intensive as they used to be the previous year. This year we have to deal with three appeals. One was not submitted properly. It is important to point out that for such matters reading carefully the provisions of the rules is the most important matter. The second one was treated by the appointed IAT and the decision is already published. The third one is work in progress by the time this report was prepared.

No mid-year meeting was scheduled but emails were exchanged between the Bureau members for various matters.

CASI Bureau prepared few proposals to amend the FAI Sporting Code General Section.

For next year CASI will have to deal for the WAG 2022 General rules. It was scheduled for this year but as long as the WAG was moved from 2020 to 2022, CASI will deal with this matter as long as all the details for this event are going to be published.

During the Plenary Meeting in Lausanne we will discuss the disciplinary procedures that can be found to the various Sections of the Sporting Code and the FAI Constitution and we will try to align them as required.

I would like to thank the CASI Bureau members and the CASI representatives for supporting CASI activities and also FAI EB and FAI HO for the good communication we have during the year.
