Volume ABR revision

(as presented at the 2015 CIAM Plenary Meeting)

 General observation: Volume ABR less and less legible because of the numerous modifications and complements adopted all along the years

Revision of the Volume ABR

- Restructuration of the document with appropriate rewording when necessary
- Amendments of some rules (clearly identified in the document)
- ★ To be effective 1st January 2017 with approval at the 2016 CIAM Plenary Meeting

Guidelines (1/2)

- Title of the Volume: ABR replaced by 'CIAM General Rules'
- Organization of the CIAM General Rules Volume
 - CIAM internal regulations (Section A)
 - General specifications for CIAM classes (Section B)
 - CIAM general rules for international events (Section C)
 - Specific rules for categories deleted from Volume ABR for inclusion in the relevant specific Volumes (concern F1, F2 and SM)
- Change of the formatting: automatic paragraphs numbering with automatic generation of a Table of contents (including a navigation link from Table of contents to the content)

Guidelines (2/2)

- Records: dedicated Volume to cover all CIAM records rules (classes F, S and U)
- Space Models: general rules included in Volume 'CIAM General Rules' as already done for model aircraft
 - Consequential adaptation of the Volume SM to prepare for 2017 Edition
- Forms, templates, tables, lists
 - No more included as Annexes of the Volume 'CIAM General Rules'
 - Downloadable on the section 'Documents' of the CIAM website
 - Gives the possibility to modify those documents outside the procedure and cycle applicable to proposals
 - ➡ Restructuration of the section 'Documents' (parts 'Forms' and 'Other Documents') of the CIAM website will be done in 2016

Rules amendments (1/4)

- Relative to section A (CIAM Internal Regulations)
 - A.1: Introduction of CIAM general provisions (constitution, aims and objectives, duties and powers, duration)
 - A.2: Introduction of rules relative to authority and automatic revision
 - A.3: Description of the CIAM organisation
 - A.5: Introduction of the possibility of a location other than Lausanne for the CIAM Plenary Meeting
 - A.6: Clarification of the Bureau composition (A.6.1) Procedure in case of resignation (A.6.3) and for dismissal (A.6.4) of a Bureau member Clarification on Bureau Meeting Minutes (A.6.6)
 - A.8: List of the current types of technical experts
 - A.9: Replacement of 'rule' by 'class' for provisional and official classification
 - A.14: Clarification for payment of the Aeromodelling Scholarship

Rules amendments (2/4)

- Relative to section B (General specifications of models)
 - B.1.1: Introduction of the definition of 'aircraft', 'aerodyne' and 'aerostat'
 - B.1.3: Clarification of the names of the model aircraft classes + Application of the noise limits to model aircraft with electric motors
 - B.2: Introduction of general specifications relative to class S
 - B.3: Introduction of general specifications relative to class U
 - B.4: Introduction of complementary definitions of expressions +
 Definition of 'ballast' deleted (to be precisely defined in the concerned class)

Rules amendments (3/4)

- Relative to section C (CIAM general rules for international events)
 - C.2: Restructure according to FAI General Section of the types of CIAM international events
 - C.3: Clarification of registration of events in the FAI Sporting Calendar
 - C.5.1.2: Deletion of the requirement that the competitor must be the builder of the model
 - C.6: Mention of the possibility to request in particular classes a valid FAI Sporting Licence for some participants (helper, mechanic, caller, ...) other than competitors
 - C.6: Mention of the dissolution of the FAI Jury according to the FAI General Section
 - C.7.4: Introduction of the World Cup Board

Rules amendments (4/4)

Relative to section C

- C.10.2: Introduction of the number of models eligible for entry in class S
- C.11.2: Introduction of the identification marks requirements for class S
- C.15.4: Clarifications relative to information bulletins for WCh and CCh
- C.15.5: Clarification on entry fees (C.15.5.1) and optional fees (C.15.5.2)
- C.20.3: Amendment relative to time limit for lodging a protest relative to the official results
- C.19: Introduction of the penalties that may be imposed by the contest director or CIAM Bureau
- C.21: Clarifications relative to CIAM trophies

FAI Sporting Licence

- 3 references for FAI Sporting licence in the FAI database
 - FAI ID number (attached to the competitor and permanent) = FAI
 Unique ID number
 - FAI licence number (this number changes every year and a competitor may have different licences on a year and so different licence numbers the same year)
 - National licence number (issued by the NAC)
- Requirement in Volume 'CIAM General Rules' of the FAI Unique ID number for
 - Identification mark of the models
 - Entry forms
 - Results of events
 - Possibility to use the National FAI licence number for identification mark of the models

CIAM classes

- Updating of the CIAM classes list (model aircraft and space models):
 - Renaming of the classes taken in account
 - Mention of 'Championship status' for the relevant official classes and of 'World Cup' for the relevant official and provisional classes
- Re-consideration of some classes to be done on behalf the relevant Subcommittees:
 - Official classes with championship status if during a 4 year period no bids for a World or Continental Championship or participation in a World Championship less than 14 countries (B.14.2)
 - Other official classes and provisional classes with no Open International in the FAI calendar (which means no effective international activity)
