1. The interference of the FAI in a matter that concerns parachuting in a clear manner without informing or consulting the IPC and unaffordable.
2. The FAI did not inform or consult Asiana in this matter which concerns the Asian continent, mainly parachuting community. The procedures and the reality of parachuting in Asia are the factors that encouraged the Asian countries to join the FAI.

*** To what extent did parachuting and the other air sports were affected during the rush to reach the Olympic Games?**

- Parachuting was the first sport that drew the attention of the world community to add it to the Olympic Games.
- The existence of parachuting in the Asian Beach Games and the attraction of the canopy piloting which were performed in the Asian Beach Games lead parachuting to the Olympic Games in a short period.
- My own point of view is that the acquaintance and discussion of parachuting will be separate and independent topic from the rest of other air sports and to be presented and discussed by the IPC President with the International Olympic Committee and OCA.
