The reason being Debra will be the Pilot in Command, and Mike is registered blind. Although Mike would not participate in a piloting capacity, Section One of the Sporting Code (4.1) clearly states that to be eligible for record claims in the Female Category that “all occupants must be female”. Any record claims from this flight would need to be made under the General Category.
