RADOJICA KATANIC (74), retired teacher of technical education, is the oldest active spacemodelling competitor in international contests. He is more than 35 years involved in spacemodelling (SM) and achieved everything a sportsman can desire: a) SM World Champion in Class S6A in 2002; b) Multiple SM World Cup medalist (including 2011 where he took 2nd place in S4A and 1st place in S6A); c) World Record holder in Class S9A (1998); d) Holder of Tupolev Diploma for outstanding world record performance (he improved previous record for 114%); e) He is the NAC SRB team member for many years. He is also father of Zoran (multiple SM WCup medallist) and grandfather of Mirko (junior World Champion 2006) and Vesna (multiple junior medallist from W and EuSMChs). He taught SM many years at his Aero Club, at his school and at different courses in Serbia and has educated hundreds of youngsters and tens of coaches, judges and time-keepers. He is also very active in international SM cooperation especially with neighboring countries and also with Slovakia, Russia, Ukraine, Spain etc. This year he and his son Zoran introduced spacemodelling in Greece providing for first spacemodellers there education, kits and necessary equipment/.....
