The core functions of CIVL Communication Officer were to report Commission and Events news on the website and social media and manage subscription mass mailing to General list and Delegates list.


In 2023 the work was done on the website, CIVLcomps and CIVL social media.





CIVL Event Management system <u>http://civlcomps.org/</u> plays an important role in sports communications. It comprises

- The biggest FAI 1, FAI 2 and Non-FAI event calendar for paragliding and hang gliding https://civlcomps.org/events

FAI 1

All FAI 1 events are provisionally published on CIVLcomps once the dates are confirmed. These events appear on fai.org only after signing of the Organizer agreement which due to some bureaucracy may take a lof of time. CIVL understands the necessity of timely informing of the pilots and NACs of the coming FAI 1 events so we put the information of CIVL official website at soon as possible.

FAI 2

Currently many organizers are in the bad practice of annoucing their event as FAI 2 long before they really get it sanctioned. For example at a random check done in december of 2023 on airtribune.com only 6 out of 17 events that declared themselves as FAI 2 were really FAI 2. 11 were not. The same situation may happen on any other website.

There is always a risk that some day some event that said it is FAI 2 will not become such. CIVL warns the community that there are only 2 places where you can get 100% confirmation if this event has really got FAI 2 status:

CIVLcomps has 2 additional unique advantages:

- For events hosted on the platform it is possible to apply directly for FAI 2 from civlcomps and then "Cat 2 pending status" will appear in the event header prooving that the sanctioning is in progress.
- Also events that are held in Non-FAI member countries or ranked as exemption are marked as such in the event header. This will serve for the pilots as a proof that such event will be ranked.



As you understand no other public website can provide verified information in these two cases.

CIVLcomps includes all necessary function for running of the event:

- Registration
- Partcipants management and notifications
- Allocation
- Trackers assignment (synchorized with Flymaster)
- Event blog
- Results publication and sending to the ranking

It is necessary for all CIVL events to upload result to CIVL comps to send them to the ranking.

Plans for 2024

- Continue developing CIVL Socials Facebook and Instagram pages.
- Provide better support for Category 2 competition organisers via CIVL Socials and Event management system
- Provide full scale support for Category 1 events with daily live reportages.
- Provide better support to CIVL organizers and pilots via civlcomps.org service.
