**PROPOSAL FOR PLACING  
MULTIEVENT REGULATION  
ON SECTION 7**

**BACKGROUND**

Paragliding has been upgrading into the next level, which are from only the Single Event level into the Multi Event level. This should be the significant achievement, since the Multi Event is more grateful by the Countries and media, compare to Single Event. The Multi event is a regular competition, which includes many sports into one event, such as Olympic Games, Asian Games, South East Asia Games, Asian Beach Games, etc.

Paragliding has been included into Asian Games on 2018 in Jakarta, Indonesia. It was very big & successful event. It was an achievement for the Air Sport, which Paragliding is the first sport who has been included into the Multi event under Olympic Games. Meanwhile, behind this success, there were so many contradictive rule between existing regulation owned by FAI-CIVL (which are mostly for Single Event) versus regulation owned by Olympic Council(OC) nor Olympic Council Asia (OCA), which are for Multi Event.

Since there are many upcoming multi events for Paragliding particularly, such as SEA Games 2025, Asian Beach Games, and also there are many potential upcoming events such as Asian Games, Winter Games, etc, Indonesia wants to propose to put new regulation for Multi Event on Section 7. Therefore, everybody could have same understanding about the environment of Multi event, and the regulation which have to be applied for Multi Event.

2. Everyone will have a clear guidelines to prepare and to run Paragliding inside the Multi Event.
3. Everyone could help to promote Paragliding to be included into Multi Event.
