2. Location(s) of the Championship:


In our proposal, we have two (2) alternative flying sites to carry out the 2nd FAI Cat 1 Pan American Paragliding Accuracy Championship Chile 2026: Geo Park in Las Vizcachas (Santiago metropolitan area) and Maitencillo, Puchuncaví (beach town located at less than a two-hour drive from Santiago). Both are described below.

The arrival of the competing pilots for either locations would be at Arturo Merino Benitez International Airport, in Santiago de Chile.





A. Geo Park Vizcacha - Puente Alto, Santiago CHILE






Geo Park Vizcacha is located at Cajón del Maipo's entrance. Cajón del Maipo is an Andean canyon located in the southeastern area of Santiago. It corresponds to high basin of the Maipo river, where it is enclosed by hills, cliffs, and massifs mountain, located in the Municipality of Puente Alto. Paragliding has been practiced in this area for more than 30 years. Due to its exceptional thermal and geographical conditions, in recent years it has become a venue for national FAI Cat 2 Cross Country, Hike&Fly, and Accuracy Paragliding championships. It has a takeoff area that can be reached by 4x4 vehicles and 2 mountain takeoffs for practicing Hike&Fly. It has a large landing area at Geo Park event center. This center is surrounded by recreational areas suited for outdoor sports, such as mini-football, airsoft, paragliding, canopy, padel, physical conditioning, wall climbing and trekking. In addition, a number of restaurants can be found in the surroundings.

The takeoff, it is located at approximately 250 meters above landing area, being a cool place as it is in a mountain area. Vizcachas offers year-round flying conditions.

Santiago is the capital and largest city in Chile. It is located in a valley surrounded by snowcapped peaks of the Andes and the Cordillera de la Costa. Along with its natural beauty, Santiago offers several urban attractions, form its main square "Plaza de Armas", at the core of city's old colonial center, to Costanera Center, the tallest skyscraper in Latinamerica. Other attractions include la Chascona, house of Nobel Prize-winning poet Pablo Neruda, and award winning restaurants at the Alonso de Cordova neighborhood.

During the October season, daily temperatures in Santiago de Chile vary from 7°C (45°F) in the mornings to 23°C (74°F) during the evenings. Nights are fairly cold with temperatures dropping down to 5°C (41°F).

B. Maitencillo, Puchuncaví CHILE





Maitencillo is the perfect mix between countryside and beach. Nestled among pines and eucalyptus trees, its beaches with calm waters and white sands are favorites among those who visit the area. The area has modern facilities and services for tourists, who can enjoy the leisure of sport.

Maitencillo has two main takeoff points accessible by any type of vehicle (as shown in the image above: A - Cerro Tacna, and B - Marbella Resort). They are located at approximately 70 meters above sea level, with the landing area at sea level on an extensive beach with soft



sands. The type of flight in Maitencillo is mainly laminar, with predominantly SW winds, ranging from 15 km/h to 20 km/h on a normal flying day.

In Maitencillo and its surroundings, you'll find activities for all tastes: restaurants with exquisite seafood cuisine, extensive beaches for sunny days, green areas for sports, and tourist activities like trekking, mountain biking, hiking, surfing, and paragliding.

It is one of the most popular spots in the central area of Chile, with significant tourist development favored by its mild temperatures and extensive beaches.

How about trying a Caldillo de Congrio, a Chupe de Jaiba, or a Paila Marina? In Maitencillo, you'll find a wide range of culinary options. Just a few kilometers away are Horcón, Quintero, Cachagua, the exclusive beach town of Zapallar; and further north, Papudo and Los Molles in the Valparaiso region. And in case of need, Santiago is only 154kms away.

- 3. Proposed Dates of the Championship: October 2026, 3rd – 11th.
- 4. Proposed Dates of the Test Event: October 2025, 9th – 12th.
- 5. Competitions Allowing the Organizer to Bid:

In October 2019, the first FAI Cat 2 Paragliding Accuracy Championship was held in Chile.

In January 2021, Chile begun holding regularly Paragliding Accuracy Championships as a competitive sport discipline. Since then, its development has been rapid due to the enthusiasm shown by authorities and athletes.

Due to its diverse geography, Chile has several locations suitable for competitive paragliding, from accuracy and hike&fly events, to cross country and acro competitions.

The sport clubs in Chile have been led by this group of organizers and collaborators in a successful way in the development of FAI Cat 2 competitions. In Accuracy, we can name the following events:

10.Pilots Entry

The maximum number of pilots is 120 (to be confirmed). Each nation may appoint a maximum of 15 pilots, and one team of up to 4 competitors with a minimum of one pilot for each sex.

This Championship will be open to all pilots of nations holding FAI Associate Member status.

13.Test Event:

The proposed dates for the Test Event will be: October 2nd to 5th, 2025.

Pilots qualifications will be defined in the Local Regulations of the event. The Test Event will be a FAI2 Open event.

Pilots: 150 US

Team Leader/Assistant: 80 US.

The entry fee will include:

- Competitor and Team Leader identification
- Transportation to takeoff (1 training day and competition days)
- Number stickers
- Lunch package during the competition
- Competition T-shirt.
- Entrance to all championship activities.

14. Third-party Liability Insurance:

All participants in the Championship must have a Civil Liability Insurance, which must be purchased in the organizing country.

Documentary proof of insurance must be presented to the organizers prior to the start of the Championship.

During the official training day, the organizer will have a local insurance agent available for riders who need insurance to purchase it on the spot.

The organizer will have special liability insurance to cover the event. In the Local Regulations, the organizer will establish the type of insurance that will be admitted both nationally and internationally.

15.Personal Insurance:

All participants in the Championship must have a personal injury insurance covering medical assistance and repatriation, which can be brought from their own country, as well as the one available from the organization.

16.Budget:

We expect to have the financial support of the Chilean Ministry of Sports, the Regional Government, companies in the sports field, travel and tourism agencies. We plan to cover about 36% of the budget with sponsorship.

Annex D – Additional Information from the Organizer

Las Vizcachas

Launch sites:

The official takeoff site 'Geo Park Vizcacha' is situated at 1,055 meters above sea level and the landing at 807 meters above sea level. With a height difference of 248 meters and a straight-line distance of 2 km between takeoff and landing, it is a clear field without obstacles; spacious and sufficient to accommodate at least 10 gliders simultaneously. It features bathrooms and a covered stay area.



Distance to takeoff area

Travel time by 4x4 car to takeoff point from landing area is 7 minutes along a wellmaintained dirt road. The takeoff area includes parking spaces and equipment preparation areas, as well as restrooms. Spacious and obstacle-free spaces ensure aerial safety and provides quick and safe vehicle access.



Landing Zone

Official landing zone is a grassy field for paragliding inflation practice, located in a large green area. The target will be located in the center of the inflation practice field, a 100x300 meter area free of obstacles and easy to spot from the takeoff point.

The approach to the landing spot is clear from all directions and offers enough space to safely leave the paraglider, rest, and rehydrate.



During competition flights, live streaming will be available via Instagram and Facebook. The public, media, and visitors can arrive by car or public transport and settle around the inflation field.



Directly opposite to the inflation (landing) field, is an area suitable for eating, refreshing, along with access to toilets and internet (wi-fi).

<u>Air field</u>

Airspace in the competition area is permanently authorized through a NOTAM by the Chilean Civil Aviation Authority for air sports practice.



<u>Climate</u>

Vizcacha is a warm climate zone, allowing a great variety of tourist offerings. In the morning, the temperature ranges between 7° and 15°; in the afternoon, between 15° and 23°, and at night around 5°, thanks to the cool breeze from the Cajón del Maipo.

These stable and permanent conditions will allow the scheduled routes of each day to be carried out continuously.




<u>Meteorology</u>

During each briefing, the designated meteorologist will present its weather forecast. Online weather stations and webcams will be placed in takeoff and landing areas.

Transportation

Transport to takeoff site will be by buses with a capacity for 30 people each. The bus transfer time is 7 minutes.

This transport will be available in the morning in front of the Head Quoter (HQ) to pick up competing pilots heading to Geo Park Vizcacha, and in the afternoon, it will take them back to the HQ. Schedule will be from 8:00 to 19:00 hour.



Safety Issues:

Championship will use mountain launch takeoff.

Since the area is exclusively dedicated to air sports, all the Air space will be exclusive dedicated to the Event.

Target will be in an inflation practice field that will allow 100% effective landings. In general, it is not a windy place, but some thermal turbulence can be expected. In October, conditions become more thermal.

The area has sanitary services and a wide green areas suitable for helicopter landings, in case of extreme urgency.

The pilot qualification competitions required for the competition are ParaPro 4.

Medical and Rescue Services

During competition flights, a doctor and an ambulance will be available in the landing area. In case of injury, competing pilots may be taken to:

- Sotero del Río Hospital (evacuation time 17 minutes, 8.8 km).
- Clinica BUPA (evacuation time 26 minutes, 16 km).

We will have permanent communications with the SAR rescue group.

Safety Management Plan

In case of incidents, we will follow FAI's "Guidelines in the event of a disaster or serious accident".

Transmissions

The use of 2M FM radios for safety reasons is allowed. The official BNAC frequency of 150.550 MHz will be reserved for the competition.

The competition areas have sufficient mobile phone coverage (5G).

Link with the police, army, and public services

Local authorities support sporting events and, if necessary, we can count on their help. The local authorities of Police, Firefighters, and Civil Protection of the municipality provide their services to sporting events.

The local road traffic authority will allow fast and safe circulation between the HQ and the flight center.

Event Headquarters (HQ)

Headquarters for the event will be located at a tourist lodge called "Los Cuernos del Toro" in the town of Las Vertientes, near the competition site.

Its facilities offer rooms for briefings, a restaurant, bathrooms, and rest areas, pools, catering to the needs of team leaders, judges, officials, and the press.

The general pilot meeting will be held in a conference room, with a capacity for 120 people. Wi-Fi will be available.



Local facilities

The site has seven beautiful tourist cabins with a capacity of up to 8 people each, all with central heating, TV, Wifi, first quality beds and maid service. In addition, there are two double rooms and one single room with maid service. Prices range from 23.00 to 45.00 USD. The organizer plans to issue a special discount card for restaurants and other local facilities, such as thermal pools, clubs, etc.

Maitencillo

Launch sites:


Maitencillo has two takeoffs that can be used for the Pan American 2026: The prefered one is locate on Cerro Tacna, next to Aguas Blancas beach. The second option, is 2Km to the north, inside Marbella Resort.

Both takeoffs are next to the beach at 60 meters above sea level and the landing area is in the beach, at sea level. Takeoff and landing areas have plenty of space for the competition and still working as a regular takoff site.



Distance to takeoff area

Travel time by regular 4x2 car to takeoff point from landing area is 5 minutes along a wellmaintained dirt road. The takeoff area includes parking space and equipment preparation areas, as well as restrooms. Spacious and obstacle-free spaces ensure aerial safety and provides quick and safe vehicle access.



Landing Zone

Official landing zone is at sea level, on the beach. Landing area is 90 meters away from the pickup point where pilots will be collected to take them back to the takeoff point. All the area is free of obstacles and easy to locate from the takeoff point. The time of the flight is around one minute.



The approach to the landing is clear from all directions and offers many places to collect the paraglider, rest, and rehydrate.

The public, media, and visitors can easily arrive by car either to the takeoff or landing area, as they wish.


<u>Air field</u>

Airspace of the competition area is authorized for practice of air sports and maintains a permanent NOTAM by the Chilean Civil Aviation Authority.



<u>Climate</u>

Maitencillo has a semi-arid climate and it barely rains. The average annual temperature in Maitencillo is 20°C and the average annual precipitation is 126 mm. It does not rain for 325 days per year, the average humidity is 50% and the UV Index is 4.



<u>Meteorology</u>

During all briefings, Meteorologist will present analysis of weather forecasts. Online weather stations and webcams will be placed in takeoff and landing areas.

Transportation

Transport to takeoff site will be by buses with a capacity for 30 people each. The bus transfer time is 6 minutes.

This transport will be available in the morning in front of the HQ to pick up participants and move to takeoff site and in the afternoon, it will take them back to the HQ. Schedule will be from 8:00 to 19:00 hour.

Safety Issues

Considering that the area is exclusively dedicated to air sports, airspace will be clear and free of obstacles.

Target will be in an inflation practice field that will allow 100% effective landings.

Maitencillo has laminar wind, with no thermal conditions at any time.

The area has a complete sanitary services and a wide green areas that will even allow the arrival of helicopters in case of extreme urgency.

The pilot qualification competitions required for the competition are ParaPro 4.

Medical and Rescue Services

During competition flights, a doctor and an ambulance will be available in the landing area. In case of injury, the participant will be transported to:

- Quintero Hospital (evacuation time 35 minutes by car/ambulance, 30Km).
- Hospital Dr. Mario Sánchez Vergara (evacuation time 45 minutes, 50Km).

We will have permanent communication with the SAR rescue group.

Safety Management Plan

In case of incidents, we will use the FAI's "Guidelines in the event of a disaster or serious accident".

Transmissions

The use of 2M FM radios for safety reasons is allowed. The official BNAC frequency of 150.550 MHz will be reserved for the competition.

The competition areas have sufficient mobile phone coverage (5G).

Link with the police, army, and public services

Local authorities support sporting events and, if necessary, we can count on their help. The local authorities of Police, Firefighters, and Civil Protection of the municipality provide their services to sporting events.

The local road traffic authority will allow fast and safe circulation between the HQ and the flight center.

Competition website

Civilcomps.org will serve as the official website for the registration of the participants and all main announcements (i.e. allocations, communication with participants, daily results, etc.). Civicomps.org website will be used as media site for sponsors and daily news of the competition.

FECHPA and FEDACH websites may be used as secondary sites.

Visas, vaccinations

For those pilots who need it, we will provide a letter of invitation to process the visa in our country.

Early arrivals

3 days prior to the event, we will provide free transportation from the airport to the flight center or event venue (HQ). Pilots arriving in advance will receive full orientation on their arrival from the airport, accommodation, logistics and flight related needs.

Customs and import of equipment

There are no customs restrictions on personal equipment.

Medals and awards

In addition to the CIVL medals and diplomas, there will be prizes from local sponsors.

Media coverage, advertising, sponsorship

The competition flights will be streamed online through the website. There will be a dedicated public relations person for the event, who will distribute news, information and results to relevant media and national television. He/she will also be responsible for live on-site commentary.

A dedicated Facebook and Instagram page will be created and maintained for the live stream of news, photos and videos before, during and after the event.

A video of the best moments of the Championship will be produced.

The landing site will be prepared for spectators and the necessary on-site facilities.

Sponsorship

The main sponsor of the Championship will be the Chilean Ministry of Sport in conjunction with the National Institute of Sport, who will provide transportation and food for the participants.

Local companies, Municipality of Puchuncavi, and Marbella Resort are entities willing to support the event.

<u>Ecology</u>

Our ecological objective is to create events that are respectful with nature. All competitions held in the Country have been conducted without generating waste or ecological impact. Food is served on reusable plates, drinking water fountains are available at take-off and landing.

Additional information supporting the offer

Chile began to participate in 2019 in the first PGAPC, and to organize Accuracy events from December 2021. Thus, in a few years it has managed to generate great athletes in this discipline. Proof of this was the Chilean participation in the last world championship of this discipline, held in Sopot - Bulgaria, where we obtained 7th place in teams and 2nd place in the Junior category.

Chile currently occupies the 1st place by teams and has 4 pilots in the top 10 of the Pan American ranking.
